1. INTRODUCTION.

Section 27(10) of the Act requires that the chairpersons of the constituency committee shall within the first year of the commencement of a new parliament and at least once in every 2 years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency. The purpose of this forums is to deliberate on development matters in the wards and in the constituency. The local committee experiences the day to day challenges in their respective areas and are therefore based on identify the challenges and needs. They are also best placed to propose and prioritize solutions to the needs in consultation with line ministries and key government agencies such as NGCDF.

In view of the above, Ward consultative forums for Limuru constituency were held as below.

1. OBJECTIVES

The key objectives were to:

- i. Identify development needs/challenges affecting the local community in the wards.
- ii. Propose needs specific solutions to the development issues identified in the forums.
- iii. Fulfill the legal requirement as stipulated in the NGCDF Act 2015.

2. METHODOLOGY

All the sub locations within each ward were notified of the proposed forum through the assistant chief and chiefs. They communicated the message to churches, mosques and notice boards. It was also placed in the various social media groups and pages. Government institutions were communicated through telephone calls.

3. PRELIMINARIES

The FAM gave a brief outline of the criteria used for the selection of projects for support by NGCDF

The CDF chairlady first introduced the New NG-CDF board members. She also elaborated the changes in the CDF Act 2015, the Ward Committee will prioritize the projects at the ward level not at the location level as it was before. They also stated that the ongoing projects should be given the first priority, CDF projects should benefit people across the section, they emphasized on making sure that every project is given funds to completion at that financial year. They also emphasized on prioritizing projects according to the needs and urgency. The meeting was informed that the ward meeting should be done yearly and CDF funds are allocated as follows according to the budget.

- Administration and Recurrent costs of CDFC up to a maximum of 6% of total annual constituency allocation.
- Emergencies 5% of the total NG-CDF kitty.
- Sports activities (minus cash awards) up to a maximum of 2% of total annual constituency allocation.
- Monitoring and Evaluation of ongoing projects and Capacity Building of various operatives up to a maximum of 3% of total annual constituency allocation.
- Environment 2% of the total.
- Bursary from 25% to 35%.
- Acquisition of vehicles, machinery and equipment:






1. The lighting of the feeder road about $\frac{1}{2}$ Kilometer with solar lighting from the main road to the school.

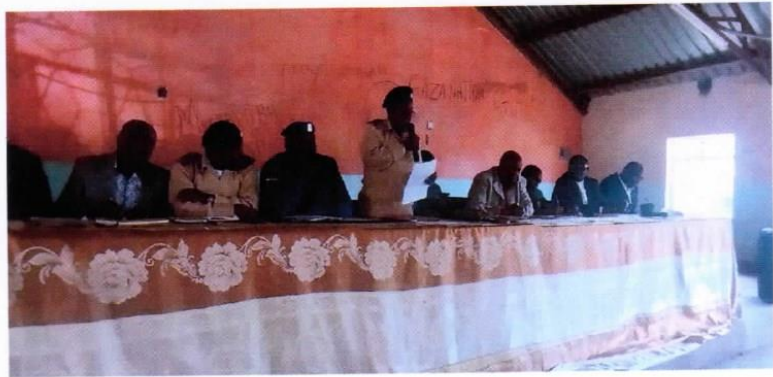

The meeting was held at Limuru Model Primary School; the school deputy Mrs. Rachael Kamau welcomed all present members and prayers led by Pr. Nehemiah Munyua.

4.1 Education Sector

4.1.1 GATIMU PRIMARY SCHOOL

Josephine Wambui (BOM chair) presented the following priorities as proposed by B.O.M and parents of Gatimu primary school.

1. Emergency Items

Ground leveling- The school to be leveled for purpose of making it useable as a playground physical education learning and playing.

First aid kit- The school requires a first aid kit equipped with all items

Security light-The school also requires a security light to boost security in the school.

Gutters for water collection-The school requires gutters to collect water

2. Classrooms- The school has a population of 430 pupils. We have classes due for splitting being grade 1,2,3,4 and 5. We also require additional classrooms for the school population. The classes will require lockers for the pupils who will occupy them.
3. Administration block-We require a school administration block that will house the head teachers' office, staffroom, store, secretary desk, printing room and meeting room.
4. Modern toilets for pupils and teachers-We require toilets for a bigger population as the school is growing and there is no need to be modern for ease of cleaning and maintenance.
5. Kitchen and dining hall- We require a school kitchen and dining hall to accommodate at least 500 pupils at a time considering that the population of the growing school.
6. Computer lab and school library-The school needs a good computer lab and library for pupils to sit when revising and reading books of all subjects. This requires tables and chairs for the pupils use in the facilities
7. Fencing and gate-The school requires fencing round the school which is currently not complete. We also need a school gate with a school moto and Logo and also a watchman house.
8. Tarmacking of the road to school- The road to school requires tarmacking for ease access to school.


