#### **MIN 03/12/2024: ON GOING PROJECTS**

The committee deliberated about the ongoing projects in the constituency. Most of the projects for FY 2023/24 were being implemented while others had not been approved by the Board.

The committee agreed to continue monitoring the projects in consultation with the Public works department to ensure that the projects are completed.

Should there be cases of variations, the committee agreed to allocate funds in the next financial year.

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**MIN 04/12/2024: PROPOSALS FOR FY 2024/2025**

The Fund Account Manager brought into the attention of the committee the Board's Circular calling for the submission of constituency project proposals as per our allocation of Kshs.188,414,052.19. The committee deliberated on all the proposals from all the public participation conducted in all the wards in the constituency putting into consideration the emerging issues including the competency-based curriculum.

The committee was informed about the junior secondary schools (JSS) identified by the Ministry of Education to receive funding for grade 9 classrooms. Out of the six schools listed, four were allocated funds, while the remaining two which had already been allocated funds in the previous financial year for construction of one classroom and renovation works. During allocation of funds the construction of one classroom, variations may occur due to terrain and cost of materials in the different areas. One classroom is allocated Kshs.1,500,000 to Kshs.1,700,000 depending on the area same applies to renovation of classrooms.

After lengthy deliberations, the committee settled on some few projects this financial year. Due to limited resources, the committee agreed to fund the remaining projects in subsequent financial years.

**MIN 04/12/2024: PROPOSALS FOR FY 2024/2025**

The Fund Account Manager brought into the attention of the committee the Board's Circular calling for the submission of constituency project proposals as per our allocation of Kshs.188,414,052.19. The committee deliberated on all the proposals from all the public participation conducted in all the wards in the constituency putting into consideration the emerging issues including the competency-based curriculum.

The committee was informed about the junior secondary schools (JSS) identified by the Ministry of Education to receive funding for grade 9 classrooms. Out of the six schools listed, four were allocated funds, while the remaining two which had already ben allocated funds in the previous financial year for construction of one classroom and renovation works. During allocation of funds the construction of one classroom, variations may occur due to terrain and cost of materials in the different areas. One classroom is allocated Kshs.1,500,000 to Kshs.1,700,000 depending on the area same applies to renovation of classrooms.

After lengthy deliberations, the committee settled on some few projects this financial year. Due to limited resources, the committee agreed to fund the remaining projects in subsequent financial years.
