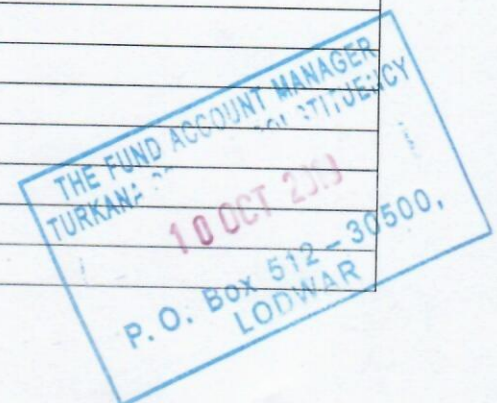

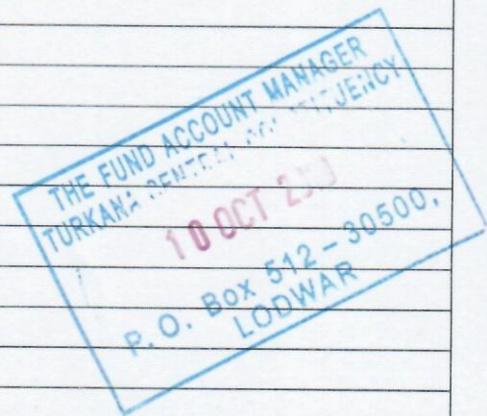

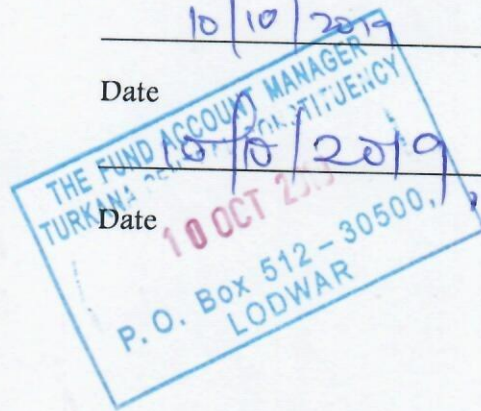

Napuu Primary School- Additional funding for Completion of remaining part of Fence-1,000,000.



