> The meetings resolved that ongoing projects shall be given precedence, to fast track


their utilization to enable the beneficiaries get value for money.

Allocations to projects should also be adequate, to enable completion of project once started, since if completion is delayed the project cost rises due to factors like inflation and wear and tear.






Lokiri Ward- Morulem Location




Lokiri Ward-Nakukulas location
