The committee members through the chairman after a short deliberations resolved to allow the schools to change the project activities and tasked the FAM to forward the request to the NGCDF Board for approval.

The total allocation for Sigor National Government Constituency Development Fund for 2019/2020 financial year is kshs 137,367,724.14

The Sigor NG-CDFCs discussed on this item at length and resolved that the above amount be spent as follows;

- Administration and recurrent expenditure is 6% kshs 8,242,063.45
- ➤ M&E and capacity building 3% kshs 4,121,031.72
- Emergency 5% kshs 7,198,241.38
- > Sports activities 2% kshs 2,747,354.48
- ➤ Environment 2% kshs 800,000.00
- ➤ Bursary, mocks and continuous assessment tests –31% kshs 43, 011,678.63
- > Primary School Projects ksh 30,900,000.00
- Secondary School Projects –ksh 30,147,354.48
- Security Projects kshs11,000,000.00

The Fund account manager briefed members on the guidelinesand requirements on preparation and submission of constituency project proposals for the 2019/2020 financial year which among them include the following:

The members deliberated on a number of issues including the challenges that are faced by PMC during the implementation of the projects. Through the chairman, Mr. Nicholas Molopointed out that there are projects situated in a very hardship areas. The members further discussed various challenges faced by PMCs in various parts of the constituency such as;

- Road and network inaccessibility
- Poor land terrain and formation
- Unavailability of technical officers in Pokot central sub county

Poor road network and lack of roads in some areas was highlighted as the main challenge in the constituency.

In line with these challenges, the committee resolved to allocate more funds in those areas with greater challenges of poor roads or no roads at all to compensate on transport. They further resolved to allocate funds depending on the challenges in those areas.

The fund account manager further advised the committee to put more funds in areas with no roads or with poor roads as recommended by internal auditors from the NGCDF Board as that will ensure completions of the funded projects.

It was further noted that the cost of constructing a classroom in Sigor Constituency ranges from Kshs 800,000 to Kshs 1,000,000 depending on the challenges experienced in those areas.

Them FAM further advised the members to add more funds to Kokwotendwo secondary school and Cheptulel boys secondary school to enable the school to acquire the 51 seater school which its price as gone up significantly. He also requested the members to also add insurance cover premiums at the additional cost. The current price of a 51 seater bus is kshs 7,162,250 against the previously budgeted amount of ksh 6,500,000. The FAM requested to add kshs 662,250.00 to cater for the additional cost of the bus. The committee resolved to resort to one off payment through cash purchase in procuring the bus and not through asset financing which is very expensive to service.

The members after a long discussion resolved to approve the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2019/2020 in all the four wards of Sigor Constituency.
