MIN 01/24/10/2019. OPENING REMARKS FRÖM AREA MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT

Area Member of Parliament Hon Mark Lomunokol gave thanks to NGCDFC Committee for their good management of the fund. He encouraged the members to continue working together in order to realize the objective of the fund in Kacheliba Constituency.

Hon Member of parliament informed members that all Constituencies in Kenya got equal share of allocation. In this financial year Kacheliba Constituency got equal share of Ksh 137,367,724.14. This is a drastic increase of 27 million from 109 million allocated in the year 2018/2019. In this financial year, the area member of parliament directed NGCDFC to put more funds in construction of secondary schools because it is a challenge in the constituency. He also encouraged members to allocate enough fund to complete a project within one financial year.



Hon Mark Lomunokol informed the Constituency Members to be careful and watchful to CDF Funds in order to realize quality educational infrastructures by using available funds allocated. He urged NG-CDFC Committees that; they are squarely responsible in any mismanagement or embezzlement of CDF projects fund in their respective Wards. All PMCs are under NG-CDFCs and therefore there going to be no excuse.

MIN 02/24/10/2018: NG-CDFC PROJECTS PROPOSAL FOR YEAR 2019/2020

The Chairman informed members that; the allocation table for Constituencies funding had been released to NGCDFC to be table in the meeting. It is a mandatory requirement to submit project proposals for the financial year 2019/2020. The Chairman also informed members that Wards project prioritization reports for 2018/2019 will be used in identifying the project for funding. However, the committee also agreed to exercise its discretion as per the provision of the Act to allocate funds to projects they consider beneficial to the community.

The ongoing projects which were funded in the year 2018/2019 are going to be completed by the PMCs now that the funds were released late as July 2019 and the same had been disbursed to respective Project Management Committees in the Constituency. All the projects in the proposal were being funded for finishing except Tantapose primary and Arol primary which were new projects. Tantapose and Odong' primary were considered far ends and their cost will be higher.

NG-CDF Board Manager Mr. Koringura informed members that National Government through Constituency Parliamentary Select Committee had allocated an equal share of **Kshs.137,367,724.14** to Kacheliba Constituency which should be deliberated upon ongoing projects and new projects that fall in the list of priorities. Ongoing projects should be given first priority in order to be completed.

Furthermore; any new project should be allocated more fund to completion as from 2019/2020 instead of piece meal funding which later attract audit queries from auditor General as well as getting value for money. Members resolved to fund the project from the start to completion to avoid repeating funding them again the following year.

The following ongoing projects allocated adequate funds in 2018/19 FY to ensure their completion as per the engineer's estimates:- Lobiroi primary, katich primary, katuda primary, lokomolo primary, lotepes primary, Nakwapuo primary, Chepsepin primary, Kapcheroro primary, Lokichar Primary, Ngotut primary, Kachawa primary, Kiwawa primary, Kodich primary, Konyao DO Office, Orolwo Chief's office, Dormitory for Nauyapong primary, 2classrooms for Kapetakinei primary, 2classes for Shongen primary, 2classes Kariamawoi primary, 2classes for Kanyerus primary, dormitory for Boralee secondary, 2classes for Sirwach primary, dormitory for Kour primary, and 2classes for Alany primary.

Holy cross secondary multipurpose dinning was conditionally approved and it was cleared. The project now needs funds for wiring and electrification. The hall accommodate more than 1500 students seated.

Included in this amount is an emergency fund of Ksh7, 197,241.38 which should remain unallocated but to cater for emergencies within the budgeted period.

The NG-CDFC committees discussed the issue of all on ongoing projects that were brought forward to this financial year to be given priority in the allocation. NGCDFC will not fully fund the amount of the engineered estimates because PMCs construct and finish the project at a lower cost as compared.

After lengthy deliberations the NG-CDFC committee agreed on the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2019 – 2020 in all the six wards for Constituency. For the purchase of buses, the amount allocated exclude insurance cover and are adequate to ensure one-off payment and the committee will not enter into asset financing.
