There is the highland region which is vast and hilly with poor road network. This region has no locally building materials like sand and stones, so acquiring and transportation of building materials from the lower region to higher region is costly

There is the lower region whereby local building materials are easily obtained nearby and the hardware materials are also easily obtained with least transportation cost. It is because of this diverse topography that has caused the variations in the allocation of funds to a project depending on the project location

The amount allocated to school buses is adequate to purchase on a one-off basis and not through asset financing, and it is exclusive of insurance premiums or any other recurrent cost.

The additional funds for the purchase of 51 seater school buses is as a results of increased prices of buses from Kshs 7,162,250.00 to Kshs 9,762,300.00

The amount allocated to purchase of school land is also adequate for purchase to completion. The land price varies depending on the location of the land.

The NG-CDF Committee unanimously resolved to approve the above Project proposal for funding in Pokot south NG-CDF funds in 2021/2022 financial year.

The committee members tasked the Fund Account Manager, NG-CDFC chairperson and secretary to move with speed in documenting the Project proposal for onward submission to the NG-CDF Board for approval.

The committee was informed that the NG-CDF Board owes the constituency kshs 12,088,879.31. The committee members urged the Fund Account Manager to fast track the last disbursement from the board in order to speed up implementation by PMCs.

## 1.0 Background on NGCDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. The funds are geared towards community driven development projects in every constituency identified and implemented at grassroots level.

The Fund is managed by the NG-CDF Board, which is a Body Corporate established pursuant to Sections 14, 15 and 16 of Act. At the constituency level, the day to day management of the Fund is vested on the National Government Constituency Development Fund Committees that are in place in each of the 290 constituencies countrywide.

The main mandate of NG-CDF Board is to consider project proposals submitted from various constituencies in accordance with the Act, approve for funding those projects proposals that are consistent with the Act and send funds to the respective constituency fund account of the approved projects.
