

KWANZA/NG-CDFC 22/09/2021 MIN.1 PRELIMINARY

The Chairperson called the meeting to order at 11.50 am and requested Mrs. Joyce Obiko to pray. She welcomed Members to the meeting requesting them to have sober deliberations due to the agendas of the meeting being very sensitive. FAM concurred with the above sentiments.

KWANZA/NG-CDFC 22/08/2021 MIN.2 READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The Secretary read the previous minutes which were proposed by Mr. Josephat Masaba and seconded by Mr. Daniel Cherwon.

KWANZA/NG-CDFC 22/09/2021 MIN.3 MATTERS ARISING

Min.4. Tabling of NG-CDF Board Disbursement 11th and Last Tranche F/Y 20220/2021 and project funding, implemented as planned.

Min5. Project Reallocation/change of Project activity – ACC office Bidii Ward and St Monica Girls secondary school. Acc office was changed from single office to storeyed building issue of St Monica Girls is in main agenda.

Min.6 Emergency funding, the cheques were issued except for St Emmanuel Primary and Bishop Muge Girls because of inadequacy of funds.

Min.7. Tabling and approval of Annual Expenditure Returns, PIS and Asset Register was tabled and adopted

Min.8. Project Proposals F/Y 2021/2022/2022/2023 was carried out as per the programme.

KWANZA/NG-CDFC 22/9/2021 MIN.4 PROJECT REALLOCATION/CHANGE OF PROJECT ACTIVITY

Change of activity Milimani Primary School

Members discussed the request by Milimani Primary School Board of Management through their Minuted dated 3rd August 2021 requesting to change renovation of colonial Building of four classrooms to construction of two new classroom.

The school had been allocated Kshs.1,400,000 for renovation of four classrooms in the Financial Year 2020/2021 but basing on assessment and recommendations of the Public works, Transport and infrastructure that the colonial building was unworthy repairing. The Public Works Officer

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discovered that the foundation floor, walls and the roof was badly damaged due to many years that the building had stayed thus rendering it unfit for renovation. After lengthy discussion Members resolved to approve the change of Project activity from renovation of four classrooms to Construction of two classrooms.

St Monica Girls Secondary School

Members further approved the change of Project activity request by St Monica Girls Secondary School Board of Management. The School had been allocated Kshs.1,600,000 (One Million Six Hundred thousand shillings only) to construct two classrooms to completion in the Financial Year 2020/2021 but due to none availability of enough Land and increased enrolment due to 100% transition Policy the School made a formal request to use the allocated amount to construct a storey building of 8 number of classrooms as a startup amount. Members further approved to allocated Kshs.13,400,000 as additional funds in the current financial year as additional funds to complete the construction of Storey Tuition Block of 8 (Eight) number of classrooms.

The same was deferred to the next meeting.



Mutua Secondary School – Additional Funds for Completion of 90 Student capacity twin laboratory (Gas system, Water system in one site of the Twin Laboratory, Fume Chamber Flooring, Plastering and Painting) – Kshs. 3,000,000. This was not capture in the earlier report on ongoing Projects submitted to the NG-CDF Board.
2. Milimani Secondary School – Additional funds for completion of a 90 students capacity twin Laboratory (Gas system in the 2nd wing, electricity, sock pit, Water tank and fitting of water goods)- Kshs 1,000,000.
3. St Cecilia Marinda Secondary School – Purchase of 51 Seater School Bus Kshs.7,000,000 The allocated amount is enough for one off payment and does not include the Insurance cost and the NG-CDF will not enter into Asset Financing.
4. St Philips Kipsoen Secondary School – Water Harvesting (Purchase and Installation of Water Gutters, Pipes @ Kshs.100,000 and 10,000 Litres Water Tank @ Kshs.100,000) Ksh 200,000.
5. Nasianda Secondary School – Water Harvesting (Purchase and Installation of Water Gutters, Pipes @ Kshs.100,000 and 10,000 Litres Water Tank @ Kshs.100,000) Ksh



1.0 Background on NGCDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. The funds are geared towards community driven development projects in every constituency identified and implemented at grassroots level.

The Fund is managed by the NG-CDF Board, which is a Body Corporate established pursuant to Sections 14, 15 and 16 of Act. 





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3.0.5 Challenges


4.1.6 Way-forward

5.1.5 Challenges



5.1.6 Way-forward


