

## 1.0 Background on NGCDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. 





### 5.1.5 Challenges

The meeting identified that there was inadequate Monitoring and Evaluation at various stages of Projects Implementation and that this could lead to compromise on the required standards on the quality of Projects. They further raised the concern for increase allocation for Projects in black cotton soil composition.

### 5.1.6 Way-forward

It was resolved that the NG-CDF Committee in consultation with the Clerk of Works be doing more frequent Monitoring Evaluation to ongoing Projects in order to ensure compliance with NG-CDF standards of Construction. 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

## 6.0 CONCLUSION
