
## Min 4/ NG-CDFSAB/05/12/2024 Prioritization of Ongoing projects

The committee discussed ongoing projects in the F/Y 2024-2025 that commenced in the previous financial years and had not received adequate funds for completion. Central Primary School was allocated Kshs.14,649,134 in the 2023/2024 financial year under the Ministry of Education (MOE) fund for the construction of a storied building comprising 8 classrooms. Phase 1 of the project involves the construction of 4 classrooms on the ground floor, completed with a suspended slab for the first floor. However, the funds have not yet been disbursed to the constituency, resulting in a delay in commencing the project thus not considered for funding in this 2024/2025

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financial year project proposal. The committee therefore committed to allocate the entire balance of Kshs. 18,350,866 in the 2025/2026 financial year. The other ongoing projects were identified as follows and the committee committed to allocate adequate funds for completion of the projects.

The Fund Account Manager briefed the meeting that the submission of the proposals for the financial year 2024/2025 is required to be submitted to the Board for approval. He also informed the meeting that the allocation for the financial year 2024-2025 is Kshs.179,441,954.47 (one hundred & seventy-nine million four hundred & forty-one thousand nine hundred & fifty-four shillings and forty-seven cents)

The members also discussed the allocation of funds towards JSS schools as per the list from the Ministry Of Education as read out by the Fund Account Manager. The list comprised of 27 schools out of which only 7 schools were prioritized reason being most schools have enough facilities for grade 9 and as per the public participation carried they were no needs in the schools.
