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1.0 BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is established under the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016. The Act is a successor to the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act of 2003 which initiated the Fund and its subsequent amendments/reviews of 2007 and 2013. At cabinet level, NG-CDF is represented by the Cabinet Secretary for the Treasury, who is responsible for the general policy and strategic direction of the Fund.

Vision

Equitable Socio-economic development countrywide

Mission

To provide leadership and policy direction for effective and efficient management of the Fund

Core Values

1. **Patriotism** – we uphold the national pride of all Kenyans through our work
2. **Participation of the people**- We involve citizens in making decisions about programmes we fund
3. **Timeliness** – we adhere to prompt delivery of service
4. **Good governance** – we uphold high standards of transparency, accountability, equity, inclusiveness and integrity in the service of the people

- National Treasury releases funds to the NG-CDF Board through the Ministry responsible for NG-CDF in quarterly tranches.
- NG-CDF Board disburses funds to the National Government Constituency Development Fund Committees NG-CDF on the basis of approved projects.



- NG-CDF disburses funds to the Project Management Committees PMC in appropriate phases through the accountant responsible for NG-CDF Currently District/Sub County Accountant

- Education sector; NG-CDF funding of schools has assisted in increasing student enrollment.
- The NG-CDF bursary has helped retain in schools' students from low income families
- Establishment of police posts and local administration offices has enhanced security network throughout the country.

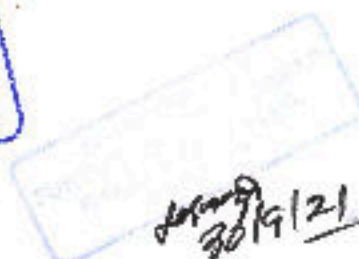



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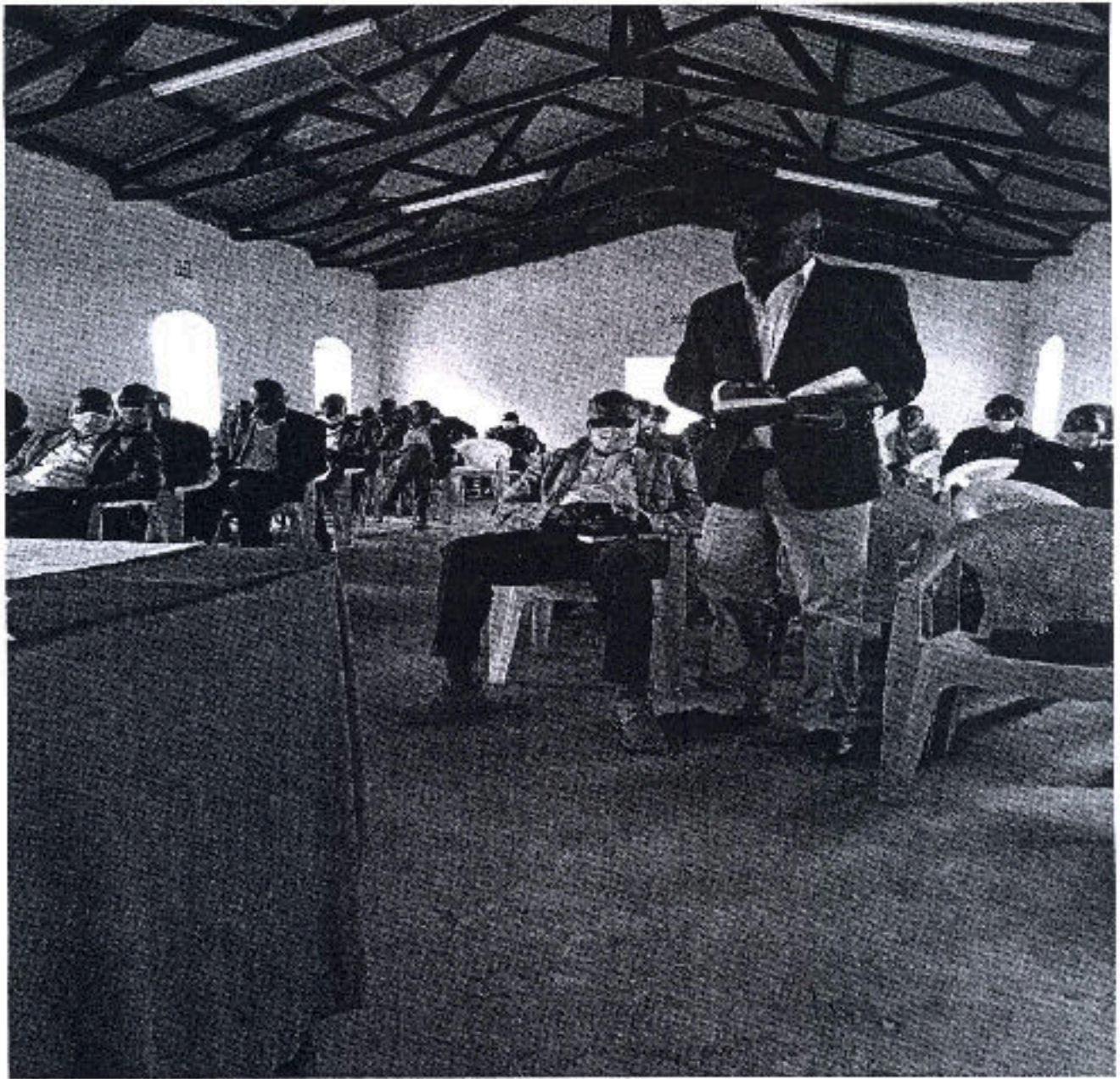


Photo 1 Segero/ Barsonbe ward public participation

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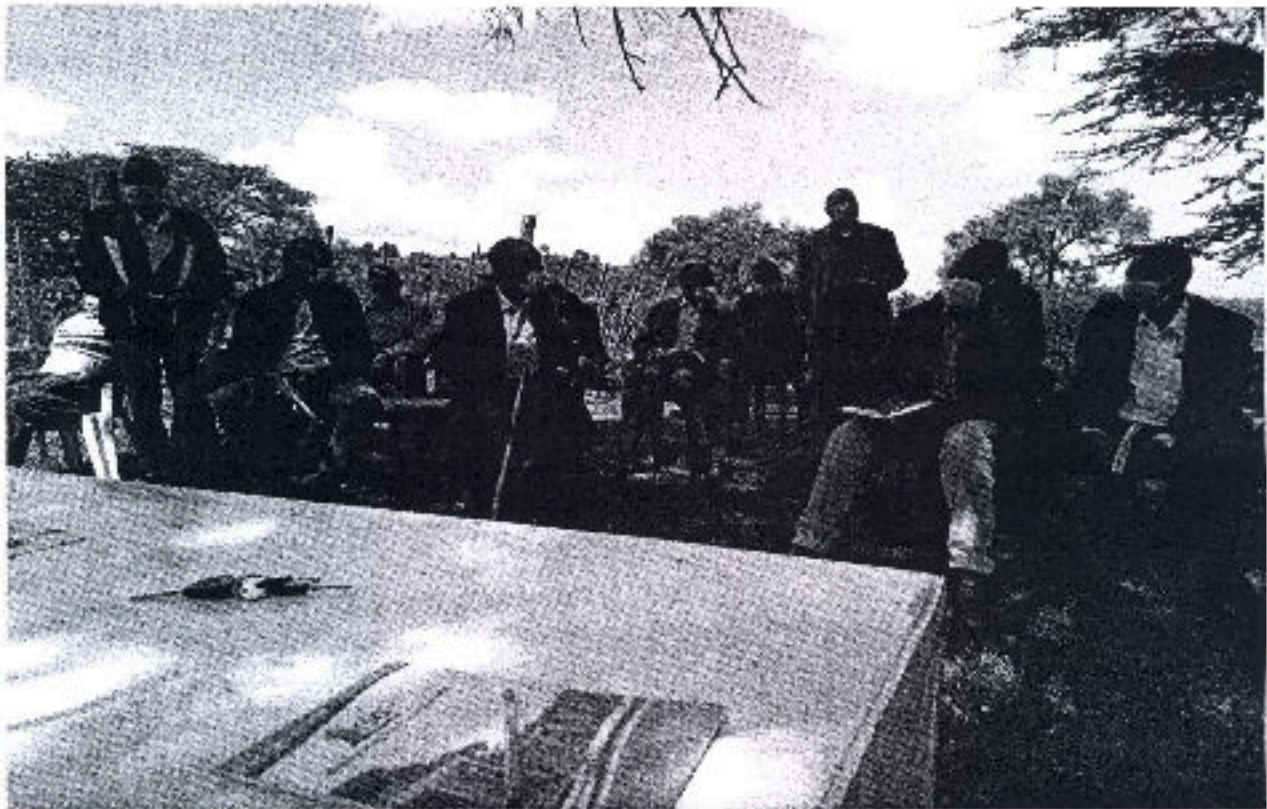
