The Chairman informed members that; the allocation table for Constituencies funding had been released to NGCDFC to be table in the meeting. It is a mandatory requirement to submit project proposals for the financial year 2021/2022. The Chairman also informed members that Wards project prioritization reports for 2021/2022 as well as the strategic objectives in the strategic plan for 2018-2022 will be used in identifying the project for funding for the next two years.

Fund Accounts Manager informed members that all ongoing projects were to be given first priority in the allocation of funds followed by high impact and best practices projects as stated in the performance Contract with NG-CDF Board for 2021/2022.
