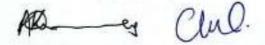
NG-CDFC MIN 06/4/11/2024: PROPOSAL FOR FY 2024/2025.

The committee in reference to the Board's circular on guidelines in preparation of proposals for FY 2024/2025, deliberated on the ward report compiled after the public participation in 3 wards namely; Ainabkoi-Olare, Kaptagat and Kapsoya. The proposals had been compiled in a priority project taking precedence.

Environment projects: The committee allocated funds to schools for purchase of energy saving jikos and afforestation of Timboroa forest. The amount allocated was less than the maximum ceiling of 5% due to the increasing need for infrastructure in schools particularly the JSS and sanitary facilities.

The committee allocated funds to 12 schools out of the 26 Junior Secondary Schools (JSS) listed by the Ministry of Education that required funding for Grade 9 infrastructure. It was noted, however, that a significant portion of these schools had previously received funding, and the existing structures were deemed sufficient to accommodate their current needs and that more funds were allocated to ongoing projects to facilitate the completion works.

The following projects were prioritized for approval in the FY 2024/2025 budget of Kshs.161,497,759.

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Background,

0.1 About NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty.

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is established under the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2023. The Act is a successor to the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act of 2003 which initiated the Fund and its subsequent amendments/reviews of 2007 and 2013. At the cabinet level, NG-CDF is represented by the Cabinet Secretary for the Treasury, who is responsible for the Fund's general policy and strategic direction.

0.2 About NG-CDF Ainabkoi Constituency.

Ainabkoi Constituency was established in 2010 having been carved off from the then Eldoret East Constituency. Ainabkoi Constituency has three wards; Kapsoya, Kaptagat, and Ainabkoi Olare consisting of 12 locations and 29 sub-locations. It has one town management structure- Eldoret Town. Additionally, there are also various main centres within the constituency.

Ainabkoi constituency is located North East of Eldoret Town. It borders Moiben constituency to the North, Kesses constituency to the North West, Keiyo South Constituency to the East, Londiani Constituency to the south, Tinderet Constituency to the south west, and Ravine constituency to the south east covers 592 square kilometres.
