Kesses NG-CDFC/90/21st September 2021: Opening remarks

Kesses NG-CDFC/92/21st September 2021: Matters arising

a) Renewal of staff contracts

The committee received requests from the four interns whose contract was extended for one year to have increment in the monthly stipend. After lengthy deliberations, it was agreed that the interns namely; Victoria Andeka, Elija Cheruiyot, Silah Marindich and Julius Kimutai receive Kshs. 15,000 every month as monthly stipend for one year.

b) Annual returns and financial statements for the year ended 30th June 2021 The committee went through financial statements for the year ended 30th June 2021 as presented to NG-CDF Board.

c) Pmc training

The committee noted that the above activity is set to commence the following day 22^{nd} September for three days up to 24^{th} September 2021. All identified pmcs have been invited. The committee further approved Strawberry Cotel and Events ltd to supply food and other

requirements for the training as per his submitted quotation of Kshs. 182,160 and be paid after the activity.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. The funds are geared towards community driven development projects in every constituency identified and implemented at grassroots level.

The Fund is managed by the NG-CDF Board, which is a Body Corporate established pursuant to Sections 14, 15 and 16 of Act. At the constituency level, the day to day management of the Fund is vested on the National Government Constituency Development Fund Committees that are in place in each of the 290 constituencies countrywide.

The main mandate of NG-CDF Board is to consider project proposals submitted from various constituencies in accordance with the Act, approve for funding those projects proposals that are consistent with the Act and send funds to the respective constituency fund account of the approved projects.

The NG-CDF Act 2016 sec 27(1) requires that the chairperson for the constituency committee shall within the first year of the commencement of a new parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forums public meeting in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency.

The previous ward meetings were held in August 2019. Proposals prioritized then were considered and some of the projects are complete while some are still ongoing. Various challenges have been faced in the process of implementation of the projects including delay of bills of quantities from county works, covid 19 pandemic among others.

In conformity to the above therefore, ward meetings were organized by the NG-CDFC Chairman inviting the Member of Parliament, ward administrators, area chiefs and assistant chiefs, NG-CDFC members and other stake holders. Various means of communication including print media, telephone calls, social media among others were used to inform the public of the intended ward meetings.

Kesses Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the constituencies in Uasin Gishu County

NG-CDF has to greater extent alleviated poverty at the constituency level. Many students some of whom are orphans have been able to realize their education goal through bursaries issued to universities, colleges, secondary and tertiary institutions.

The committee has a number of challenges, the constituency being vast the issue of project monitoring has been difficult. Secondly, the constituency has many poor residents hence the applicants for bursary are overwhelming hence leading to awarding of little to the beneficiaries.

The constituency is mostly cosmopolitan, but the major tribes are the Kalenjins and Kikuyus speaking communities. Most of the residents of the Constituency are poor and depend on livestock and crop farming for their livelihood.

2.0 WARD MEETINGS

2.1 Tarakwa ward

The meeting was conducted on 14th September 2021 at Tarakwa chief office ground starting 10am to 1pm. At least 120 participants attended the meeting. The area chief and their assistants and village elders were among those present in the meeting. The meeting was opened with a word of prayer and thereafter introduction took place.

The ward is the largest in the constituency with a total of 47 public primary and secondary schools. The master of ceremony for the day invited Bishop Gathuo who is a representative of the ward in the Ng-cdf committee to address the members. He thanked them for finding time to attend and he briefly informed the people the nature of projects that can be funded by NG-CDF and highlighted the development projects undertaken within the ward for the last four financial years. He noted that a total of Kshs. 90million and above had been disbursed to fund projects within the ward. Further, a total of Kshs. 20million and above had been disbursed as bursaries to Tarakwa residents. At least all schools had benefited from one or more projects from the fund. Being the chairman for KeRRA, he took time to enlighten participants on the roads projects funded and upcoming projects.

Afterwards the NG-CDFC chairman and Fam briefed the residents on the functions that can be undertaken by the fund. They took time to explain the reasons behind NG-CDF funding only education and security projects. Religious and political bodies cannot be funded by Ng-cdf.

The NG-CDFC Chairman thereafter took to the stage to welcome the people to give out their views.

Finally, the FAM reiterated that even though some of the proposals given could not be funded by NG-CDF, the pmcs should be patient for future funding. Further the county government would hold similar meeting hence advised the residents to come out in large numbers when they meetings are called.
