NG-CDFC RESOLUTIONS ON THE CORRECTIONS COMMUNICATED BY THE DESK OFFICER

The NG-CDFC sat in their meeting on 5th December 2018 and harmonized the activities and amount allocated to each project as advised by the Board's desk officer to North rift.

Variations in the allocations depends majorly on the location of the project, some along Kerio valley and others along highlands hence variation in the cost of transport and materials.

Chesoi primary school is complete after being given ksh 800,000 in financial year 2016/2017 and do not require a new project currently.

Chesoi unit for deaf is also complete after funded with ksh 250,000 for completion in the financial year 2016/2017.

Metipsoo primary school awaits ksh 500,000 for completion of two classrooms which has been recently the NG-CDF Board.



Kaptobendo primary school is done up to the roof and it is the opinion of NG-CDFC members that ksh 600,000 is enough for plaster, flooring, doors, windows of 2 classes.

Koibarak primary school has recently changed its name to Konot primary school, so the NG-CDF has allocated Ksh 1,000,000 for plaster, flooring, windows glasses and painting of 5classes thus Koibarak is captured well.

Mokoro and Ketut Chiefs offices have each received ksh 200,000 for completion and are now complete. The amount allocated to Mokoro chiefs office was a case change of activity whereby the re-allocation letter from the Board was received recently.

Some projects are accessible by road while others are inaccessible hence the high cost of transportation of materials e.g cement and sand.
