MIN 001/16-17/9/2021: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES.

Minutes were read by the secretary, confirmed by Hasca Kotich and seconded by Paul Chelimo.

MIN 002/16-17/9/2021: MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MINUTES

On N.H.L.F the members noted that some beneficiaries who had been selected for the program were opting for UHC program hence creating confusion. Members deliberated and tasked the FAM to consult further with N.H.L.F on the best way forward.

MIN 003/16-17/9/2021: PROJECT PROPOSAL 2021-2022

As earlier agreed through Min. 06/14/09/2021 on the preparation of 2021/2022 project proposal, the members deliberated and agreed that from the total allocation of Kshs.

187,088,879;

1. Emergency projects – 7,192,207
2. Administration and recurrent – 7,946,127
3. Monitoring and evaluation – 3,896,545
4. Bursary and Social Security – 34,000,000
5. Secondary, primary, tertiary, environmental and sports – 84,054,000

It was agreed that all the ongoing projects to take precedence. In addition, Kerio Valley K.M.T.C in Marakwet East Constituency be allocated Ksh 10,000,000 (Ten Million) for the construction of Multi-purpose Hall as per their request. NG-CDFC would wish to clarify the following;

1. For the on-going projects NG-CDFC would wish to confirm that the amounts allocated are adequate to complete the pending works.
2. The completion of classroom for Kipkandul Dry Secondary School is in addition to their request for change of activity from construction of pit latrines to the construction of a classroom as per MIN04/16-17/09/2021.
3. The disparity in the cost of classrooms is as a result of the additional works in the high cost classrooms i.e. ceiling and tiles/terrazzo.
4. For Chiburi Boys Secondary School the dormitory is one storey with a total capacity of 300 students. NG-CDF Marakwet West is completing the ground floor which has a capacity of 150 students.
5. For Kirnai Girls the additional funding is for equipping the Dining Hall.
6. St. Paul School Primary School has been officially registered in this name.



1.0 Background on NG-CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2013 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. The funds are geared towards community driven development projects in every constituency identified and implemented at grassroots level.

The Fund is managed by the NG-CDF Board, which is a Body Corporate established pursuant to Sections 14, 15 and 16 of Act. At the constituency level, the day to day management of the Fund is vested on the National Government Constituency Development Fund Committees that are in place in each of the 290 constituencies countrywide.

The main mandate of NG-CDF Board is to consider project proposals submitted from various constituencies in accordance with the Act, approve for funding those projects proposals that are consistent with the Act and send funds to the respective constituency fund account of the approved projects.

Marakwet West Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the constituencies in Elgeyo-Marakwet County.




