MIN 1/09/2021: PRELIMINARIES

MIN 2/09/2021: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and confirmed as true deliberations of that day by Maureen Keror and seconded by John Chirchir.

MIN 3/09/2021: MATTERS ARISING

The CSR project-The ongoing construction of dormitory at lintel level, the contractor for the second time delayed the project and he 3 weeks behind the schedule.

Monitoring and evaluation exercise was done and the committee members were able to also validate the priorities for FY 2021/2022 which had been proposed during the last years' public participation. Following the visits few areas with gaps were noted among them Kapkei primary school-The PMC could not justify the utilization of Kshs.700,000 to construct two walled classrooms, they were expected to make savings which they did not, Delays in implementation of emergency project by PMC for Kiptoro primary school, Kayoi primary school and Chegilet secondary school.

Most of the schools were commended for the implementing projects timely and according to the required standards.

Benchmarking-Could not materialize as planned to various commitments which include review and submission of financial statements, and proposals,

The committee resolved to reschedule the exercise to Mid -October and to be undertaken as previously planned.

MIN 4/09/2021: APPROVAL OF PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR FY 2021/2022

The FAM informed the members that the NGCDF board released the allocation table to the constituencies and a circular on the same. The FAM took the members through the circular from the board and members noted the contents.

The chair reminded the members that as they prioritize this financial year's projects as per the guidelines from the board, they should ensure that they are in line with the strategic plan. The members were then taken through the action plans agreed upon during the mid-term review of the strategic plan.

The FAM tabled the priorities captured during the public participation last year and validated during the last M & E exercise.

The committee went through the project proposals and approved for funding as follows._

Kapsio Primary School was captured as one of the ongoing projects but has not been allocated additional funds for acquisition of land since the seller withdrew from further negotiations with school after the land was valued at lower rate than what the seller was expecting. The committee to review this later for the way forward.



The committee after deliberations, approved the hiring of an accounts assistant and the process to start immediately which should be undertaken competitively through a recruitment process in order to get a qualified person.

MIN 6/09/2021:- EMERGENCY REQUESTS & REALLOCATIONS

EMERGENCY REQUESTS

 Kabulwo Primary School-request for emergency funds to construct 4 door pit latrines for teachers to replace the one which has collapsed. The committee approved KSh.250,000/- to construct 4 door pit latrine.

 Kapchelal Secondary School- Request for emergency funds to construct 4-door pit latrine for teachers. The committee approved Ksh.200,000/= to construct 4 door pit latrine for teachers.

 Kendur Primary School-request for emergency funds to construct 4-door pit latrine for boys to replace the one which sunk. The committee approved KSh.200,000/= to

construct 4 door pit latrines.

 Kokwao Secondary School- The school is requesting for funds to construct furrows to direct away storm water which has been causing destruction to the school structures. The committee approved the funding to help protect the school from storm water which usually floods the classrooms during rainy season.

REALLOCATIONS

Reallocation of part of emergency funds for the last financial year.

- KMTC Iten- the college has shortage of classrooms for students and some are currently learning in tents. This is as a result of the high number of students admitted to college, The pressure for the classes is too high that it cannot wait till the funding for this financial year. The committee approved the reallocation of emergency funds Ksh. 1, 600,000 for construction of two classrooms to completion.
- Moi Tambach Primary School- The school is currently constructing a storey tuition block with a total of 14 classes- seven on the ground floor and seven on the first floor. The project is to be co-funded with the school and will be done in phases. The school had to demolish the old semi-permanent classes to create space for construction of the new block. The school had requested Tambach TTC to accommodate the pupils temporarily as there were no students in college, however, the Ministry of Education has admitted Diploma Teachers students and are reporting for admission on 4th October, 2021 at the college hence displacing the primary school pupils learning in college. The school administration is unable to complete the ground floor as expected as they were relying on fees collection. They are therefore requesting for Ksh.1M to enable them complete the ground floor to be ready for occupation come second term. Due to this urgent need, the committee approved the reallocation of KSh.1, 000,000 from emergency funds for completion of the classrooms-Plastering, flooring, and tiling of the 7 classrooms.
