The public participation exercise was a great success though during the identification process there were some challenges i.e.

- Some people are yet to distinguish between national government and county government functions.
- There was a proposal that bursary be increased by amount and number of beneficiaries.
- There is a confusion between roads handled by KERRA and county government.
- Electricity issues also emerged.

MIN:5/27/04/2023 STATUS OF PROJECTS PROPOSAL FOR 2022/2023 FINANCIAL YEAR .

Project proposals for 2022/2023 for Tinderet constituency has not been approved by NG-CDF Board. This was because the on-going projects had not been allocated adequate funds. Based on the recommendations from NG-CDF board following their visit dated 7th April 2023, NG-CDFC had engaged the public works officers to assist in the preparation of cost estimates based on the pending works. Based on the public works report NG-CDFC agreed to allocate funds to ongoing projects as follows:

Kshs 138,565,433 has been allocated to Tinderet Constituency in the financial year 2022/2023.


