

## **CHESUMEI WARD REPORT FOR THE PERIOD 2021/22-2022/23**

### **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

National Government Constituency Development Fund Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

#### **1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF**

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NGCDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF



Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

## **1.2 ABOUT CHESUMEI NG-CDF**

Chesumei Constituency is in a rural area with a few urban settings like Chepterit, Mosoriot and part of Kapsabet Town. It covers an area of approx. 470 sq Kms with an estimated population of 130,752 people.

Chesumei Constituency as a whole was formed from the former Emgwen Constituency and has five wards, namely Chemundu /Kapngetuny, Kiptuiya, Kosirai, Lelmokwo /Ngechek and Kamoiywo.

The constituency is located in Nandi county and borders three (3) constituencies, namely Emgwen to the South, Mosop to the North and Kesses to the East.

#### **Eligible Projects Fundable by Chesumei NG-CDF**

The eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF as stipulated in section 24 of the NG-CDF (Amendment) Act, 2016 as those that are in:

- Respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the constitution
- Must be community based to ensure that the prospective benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area.

The ineligible projects include:

- Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities
- Projects supporting political bodies or political activities
- Recurrent costs of a completed projects
- Personal awards
- Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others
- Projects addressing devolved functions as outlined in the fourth schedule of the constitution of Kenya

**3.2.2 PRELIMINARIES / COMMENTS BY THE AREA CHIEF**

The area chief of Mutwot Location welcomed members to the meeting after an opening prayer. He thanked the people present for attending the important development forum. He introduced the ward development committee and appreciated their efforts towards development on the area.

**3.2.3 COMMENTS BY THE DEPUTY COUNTY COMMISSIONER**

He explained to the meeting the history of rural development funding in Kenya Since independence in 1963 aimed at fighting poverty at the grassroots level has been one of the key agendas of the Kenyan government. The government has initiated various rural development programmes including Special Rural Development Programme, District Development Planning,



Rural Development Fund and the District Focus for Rural Development Strategy with the aim of improving people's wellbeing.

However, most of these programmes failed to address the needs of local people due to lack of political will, inadequate government funding, lack of appropriate technology, neglect of institutional development, lack of beneficiary participation and poor coordination from top to the bottom. However, in 2003 the government introduced Constituency Development Fund (NG-CDF), to fight poverty at the grassroots and since its inception; NG-CDF has had tremendous impact among the rural communities in Kenya

### 3.2.4 COMMENTS BY THE FUND ACCOUNT MANAGER

He enlightened the members about the eligible projects fundable by NG-CDF and ineligible projects which are fundable by devolved systems, and also briefed the meeting on the statutory ceilings specified in the NG-CDF Act 2015 which guide the NG-CDFC during projects funding. She also stressed that after the exercise in all the wards the NGCDFC will rank the projects in order of priority and that the that on-going projects shall take precedence over all other projects

### 3.2.5 COMMENTS BY THE NG-CDFC CHAIRMAN

The chairman appreciated the members concern for development, he highlighted that NGCDF has achieved a lot towards development in the constituency, and the overall aim of this is to ensure active participation of people in the achievement of sustainable development.

### **3.5.3 COMMENTS BY THE AREA CHIEFS**

Kapchorwa Assistant Chief lauded NG-CDF efforts in development in the area and the constituency at large, since all the initiated projects have been implemented satisfactorily. He however appealed that NG-CDF should allocate more funds to the area since it is the only government fund being felt by the constituents.

### **3.5.4 COMMENTS BY THE FUND ACCOUNT MANAGER**

He alluded that NG-CDF only funds community-based projects meant to serve community needs in the constituency and have long-term positive effects on people's wellbeing and also gave a briefing on the ineligible projects. He further asserted Co-funding is also allowed where a project can be financed jointly with neighboring constituency or from sources other than the Fund so long as the other financiers or donors of that project have no objection, and provided that the part funding for the project availed pursuant to the NG-CDF Act 2015 shall go to a defined unit or phase of the project.

### **3.5.5 COMMENTS BY THE NG-CDFC CHAIRMAN**

He stated that the office will undertake a continuous sensitization of the citizens to encourage them participate in NG-CDF affairs through M&E, budget tracking and social audits. This will increase efficiency and effectiveness in NG-CDF projects management by the people and enhance ownership of the projects by the community.


