MIN 01/29/SEPTEMBER/2021/2022/11: PROCEEDINGS.

Chairperson called the meeting to order at 10:20Am, thanked members for their punctuality in attending the meeting, requesting for a social distance of one metre apart. He then requests Getrude Sugut to lead with a word prayer.

MIN 02/29/SEPTEMBER/2021/2022/11: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF THE PREVIOUS MINUTES.

The secretary read the previous minutes of the meeting held on August 18, 2021. The minutes were proposed by Julius Maiyo and seconded by Rael Jeptum as the true records of the proceedings of that day.

MIN 03/29/SEPTEMBER/2021/2022/11: MATTERS ARISING.

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FAM informed the committee members that following the recent funds disbursement by the board, he has mobilized for PMC documentation to enable process of the funds and disbursed to their respective accounts, for the projects to commence immediately. The technical team from public works should ensure quality workmanship is observed to the later.

Chair informed the committee that all ongoing projects are going on well despite Covid 19 regulations, the institutions are observing keenly. Members agreed to visit the ongoing projects for their routine check on the progress.

MIN 04/29/SEPTEMBER/2021/2022/11: EMGWEN NG-CDF PROJECT PROPOSALS SUBMISSION OF FINANCIAL YEAR 2020/2021

The Fund Manager informed members that the budget ceiling per Constituency in 2020/2021 is Kshs 137, 088,879.

The chairman tabled the project proposals from the four wards in the constituency before the committee for deliberations, the proposals tabled were for the following wards: Kilibwoni, Kapsabet, Kapkangani and Chepkumia ward.

The chairperson noted that some of the projects were not completed due to rise of prices of local and hardware materials, classrooms were redesigned to a standard classroom of 8 X 9 meters and the introduction of gal sheets from MRM. After a long discussion the committee agreed that the ongoing projects to be funded in this Fy 2021/2022 as per their estimate costs to completion to enable benefit the community.

The chairperson noted that most of the institutions across the constituency have experience a lot of challenges with ablution block, the committee discussed and agreed to fund neediest with environment funds.

The Chairperson informed the committee that the new secondary school Kipkeibon had received attraction of 135 new form one students and the TSC has posted a new principal to the institution.

Also he noted that there were several variations on extra works which was advised by the technical officers from public works to be observed and corrected by the contractor, the extra works on variations for completion was the steel beam reinforcement (25mm, 20mm and 8mm diameter bar) at kshs. 576,000, floor finishes (330x330x6mm pvc floor tiles on backing provisional cement grout on floor) at kshs. 630,000, roof finishes (28 gauge pre painted corrugated roofing sheets at kshs. 908,000, 28 gauge ridge cap to match at kshs. 106,000, ditto valley plain sheet gauge 28 at kshs. 75,000, floor finishes (330x330x6mm ceramic floor tiles on backing provisional cement grout on floor) at kshs. 935,000. The totals to approximate estimates costs for the variations should be kshs.3,200,000, where the original cost estimates from the engineers was kshs. 30,000,000.00.

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The committee anonymously agreed to consider as a priority to clear any outstanding ongoing projects to benefit the community.

The committee also noted some ongoing projects which their estimates changed, previously the estimates from the public works department was for full contract but from the previous designing to implementation of labour based which is cost effective and faster because of local available materials. The committee opt for labour based to some of the projects where technical officer from the public works will proper supervises the project at every progress and frequent monitoring and evaluation by the committee, which the cost estimates were changed as follows;

The committee went through the proposals one by one and found out that most of the projects that had been forwarded were:

1. Secondary schools
2. Primary schools
3. Security

The Fund Account Manager took members through the regulations guiding the preparations of project proposals, NGCDFB circular and particularly the statutory. He stressed to members that the NGCDF board is very strict and that an allocation of funds to a project should be able to complete that project. He went further to remind members that any ongoing projects should be given priority so that are completed and handed over to the community for use.

After going through the statutory, the committee observed that the amount of money available was so little to be able to cater for the projects they had intended to fund in this financial year. The Committee approved allocations of **Kshs. 137,088,879.00** to Fund projects. The attached list of projects was therefore anonymously accepted by the committee and recommended for funding in the financial year 2021/2022 as follows;

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

1.0 Background on NGCDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. The funds are geared towards community driven development projects in every constituency identified and implemented at grassroots level.

The Fund is managed by the NG-CDF Board, which is a Body Corporate established pursuant to Sections 14, 15 and 16 of Act. At the constituency level, the day to day management of the Fund is vested on the National Government Constituency Development Fund Committees that are in place in each of the 290 constituencies countrywide.

The main mandate of NG-CDF Board is to consider project proposals submitted from various constituencies in accordance with the Act, approve for funding those projects proposals that are consistent with the Act and send funds to the respective constituency fund account of the approved projects.

Emgwen Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the constituencies in Nandi County
