## MIN2/03/BN/NG-CDFC/SEPTEMBER/2020 - PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2020-2021

The manager informed members that the constituency has been allocated **Kshs.** 137,088,879.31 for financial year 2020/2021. Out of this total amount, emergency is **Kshs.** 7,192,206.90. There is also Authority to Incur Expenditure (A.I.A) of **Kshs.** 166,000 totaling to **Kshs.** 137,254,879.31.

The members resolved to allocate the remaining funds to ongoing projects as per priorities given by the community after the statutory deduction. However, all the prioritized projects will not be considered in this financial year because there is limited funds compared to the projects requiring funding.

- 8. Litein Primary school Kshs. 600,000 for completion of Two classrooms funded by the community up to lintel level
