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Min 07/08/11/2024: Deliberation and approval of 2024/2025 project proposal in line with the ward report and strategic plan.

The chairperson welcomed the Fund Manager to read through the ward report that was obtained after public participation which was carried out on 4th -7th November 2024 in every ward.

The committee also observed that, under climate mitigation projects, the number of schools to be allocated funds for tree planting was reduced. This decision was necessitated by the need to reallocate resources to ongoing projects requiring additional funding for completion. Consequently, an allocation of Kshs.1,900,000 was approved for tree planting initiatives.

Regarding the Junior Secondary Schools (JSS) 37 listed by the Ministry of Education, the committee allocated funds to 13 schools in the current financial year. This decision was guided by the need to prioritize the completion of numerous ongoing projects that required additional funding. However, the committee resolved that these schools will be considered for funding in the next financial year.

The members deliberated on the ward priorities based on the ward forums and approved the following projects as per allocated funds of Kshs.179,441,954.47
