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1.0 Background on NG-CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is established under Section 4 of the NG-CDF Act 2016 as amended in 2016, with an objective of addressing poverty and regional development imbalances by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the National Government share of annual revenue as divided by the annual Division of Revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution. The funds are geared towards community driven development projects in every constituency identified and implemented at grassroots level.

The Fund is managed by the NG-CDF Board which is a Body Corporate established pursuant to Sections 4, 15 and 16 of Act. At the constituency level, the day-to-day management of the Fund is vested on the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Committees that are in place in each of the 290 constituencies country wide.

The main mandate of NG-CDF Board is to consider project proposals submitted from various constituencies in accordance with the Act, approve for funding those projects proposals that are consistent with the Act and send funds to the respective constituency fund account of the approved projects.

Baringo South is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the constituencies in Baringo County.

- V. Projects targeting a specific club or group of people

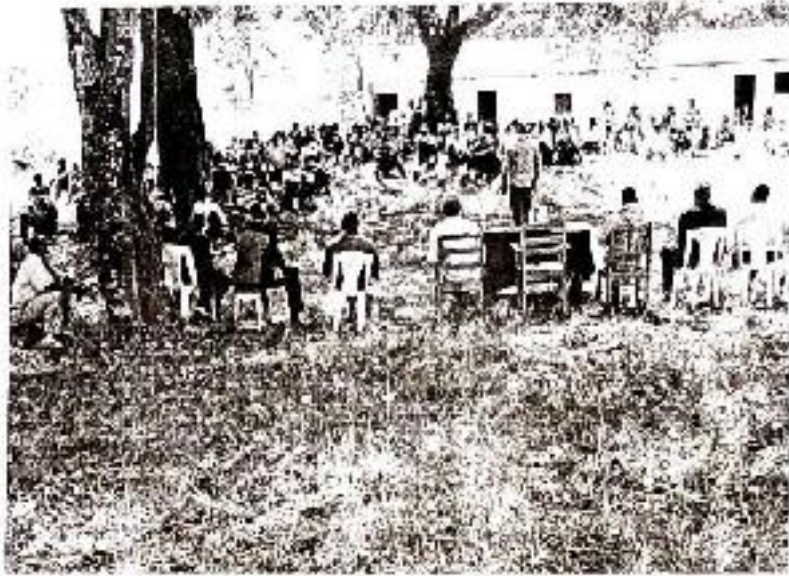

By Vincent K Sibilo-Accounts Assistant the Nature of Projects in respect to NG-CDF Act

Mr Vincent Sibilo alluded that NG-CDF only funds community-based projects meant to serve community needs in the constituency and have long-term positive effects on people's wellbeing and also gave a briefing on the ineligible projects.

He further asserted that Co-funding is also allowed where a project can be financed from sources other than the Fund; so long as the other financiers or donors of that project have no objection and provided that the part funding for the project availed pursuant to the NG-CDF Act 2015 shall go to a defined unit or any part thereof or phase of the project in order to ensure that the particular portion defined in the allocation is completed with the funds allocated under this Act.

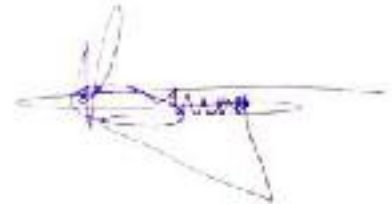
