MIN 1/13/11/2024: PRELIMINARIES.

The chairman welcomed members to the meeting. Opening prayers were conducted by Samuel Cherutich. He thanked the members for their punctuality and asked the secretary to read out the minutes of the previous meeting.

MIN 2/13/11/2024: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES.

The secretary read out the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were proposed by Hellen Cheptoo and seconded by Renson Ole Matilio as a true reflection of what was previously discussed.

MIN 3/13/11/2024: MATTERS ARISING.

 MONITORING AND EVALUATION: The FAM informed members that the scheduled M&E was not able to materialize due to the unavailability of funds.
 Members insisted on the urgency of M&E since most projects were ongoing and

needed to be monitored and evaluated to ensure quality of the projects and proper utilization of the funds. Members agreed to schedule the M&E as soon as funds become available.

- REPORT ON PUBLIC PARTICIPATION OF PROPOSALS OF THE NEW ALLOCATIONS: The secretary read out the prepared report and shared pictures of the public participation of proposals of the new allocations which in a nut shell was the request of the residents of Baringo South that bursary allocations be increased from the ksh.500, 000 to ksh. 700,000 per sub-location. The report also pointed out that more projects on the education sector was needed as well as security, environment and water supply projects in schools. The chairman informed members that thirty two JSS classrooms were to be funded by the ministry of education in collaboration with NG-CDF so duplication during the final draft of the proposal should be avoided. Attached is the report and the list of the 32 schools that will get JSS classrooms funded by the ministry of education in collaboration with NG-CDF.
- ENVIRONMENTAL DAY: The chairperson environment sub-committee reported to
 members that on 10/10/2024 NG-CDFC together with their staffs, constituency staffs
 and residents of Baringo South participated in a tree planting exercise in the NG-CDF
 offices and some nearby schools like Yatoi primary school and Marigat primary
 school. This was to mark Huduma day and support the president's directive of
 planting over ten billion trees. The project was a success as over 1000 seedlings were
 planted and distributed.

MIN 6/13/11/2024 DELIBERATION AND APPROVAL OF PROPOSALS FOR FY 2024/2025 IN LINE WITH WARD REPORT AND STRATEGIC PLAN PROPOSALS FOR FY 2024/2025.

The chairperson gave members a chance to bring forward proposals for the FY 2024/2025 from wards (locations) captured in public participation. The Fund Account Manager informed the members that the constituency had been allocated Kshs.170,469,856.74 for the 2024/2025 financial year for budgeting.

The committee noted that construction of pit latrines and classrooms may vary depending on distance and terrain of the constituency

Regarding the Junior Secondary Schools (JSS) listed by the Ministry of Education, the committee allocated funds to 5 schools in the current financial year out of 55 schools. This decision was guided by the report from the schools who were in need of classrooms and that most schools have sufficient classrooms for grade 9.

Environmental projects were not allocated the entire 5% since the schools within the constituency have no measures to sustain them hence allocating only Kshs.2,300,000 out of Kshs.8,523,492.00







Government under the Constitution, which must also be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area.

He further encouraged the community members to give consideration to project proposals that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity and protection of the marginalized as per Article 10 of the Constitution that outlines national values and principles of governance.

Constituency Committees shall exclude project proposals that fail to meet the eligibility criteria for NG-CDF funding, such as: -

- *Projects supporting political bodies or political activities
- *Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities
- *Recurrent costs of completed project(s)
- *Personal awards, except education bursary for students from needy families and projects on healthcare financing targeting vulnerable families under social security programmes
- *Projects targeting a specific club, society or a group of people to the exclusion of others
- *Projects addressing devolved functions as outlined in the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya.





The residents were promised that security institutions will be constructed to improve on security issue



The Nature of Projects in respect to NG-CDF Act

Mr Vincent Sibilo alluded that NG-CDF funds is a community-based projects meant to serve community needs in the constituency and have long-term positive effects on people's wellbeing and also gave a briefing on the ineligible projects.

He further asserted that Co-funding is also allowed where a project can be financed from sources other than the Fund: so long as the other financiers or donors of that project have no objection and provided that the part funding for the project availed pursuant to the NG-CDF Act 2015 shall go to a defined unit or any part thereof or phase of the project in order to ensure that the particular portion defined in the allocation is completed with the funds allocated under this Act.


