1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Constituency Development Act 2013 stipulates that the CDF should convene open forum public meetings at its every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development projects and project priorities in the ward and the constituency at large, where community members get the opportunity to identify development projects for implementation. These are then prioritized by the Constituency Development Fund Committee (CDFC) after an analysis of the same.

The exercise was carried out over a period of four days in all the 6 wards in the constituency.

Citizen participation in project implementation. Members of the public involvement in the implementation of NC CDF projects has been through the Project Management Committees (PMCs) which comprise of members of the public who manage and oversee the implementation of individual NC CDF projects.

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process.

Stakeholder engagement broadly refers to a framework of policies, principles, and techniques which ensure that citizens and communities, individuals, groups, and organizations have the opportunity to be engaged in a meaningful way in the process of decision-making that will affect them, or in which they have an interest. Thus, public participation can be recognized as a practice of stakeholder engagement.

1.1 ABOUT CDF

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 10th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2013. The CDF Act provides that the Government set aside at least 2.9% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The Fund was designed to support constituency level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to channel initiatives in regional development brought about by partisan politics.

It targets all constituency level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty in the grassroots and outreach vulnerable distribution of development.

1.2 ABOUT LAKEURIA WEST NG-CDF

Lakeurua West Constituency is an electoral constituency in Kenya. It is one of the three constituencies in Lakeurua County. The constituency was established in the year 1996 elections. It has six electoral wards namely:

6. Oltharua ward

2.2 BURSARY DISBURSEMENT CRITERIA IN 2021/2022 FINANCIAL YEAR

A clear system of bursary disbursement has been clearly established. The process commences with the placement of an application form by the potential beneficiary.

The received forms are entered into data as they come and an applicant's register which serializes every application form, and contact number of the person who has submitted the form respectively captured in the register to avoid cases or claims of lost forms and non-submissions.

The application form is brief but detailed to allow for critical evaluation of the status of the applicants. All applicants in the financial 2020/2021 received bursaries.

The award figures are pegged on the various cadres of colleges, Secondary Schools and Special Schools as tabled below as resolved by the Bursary Subcommittee and CDFC.

The meeting resolved that several workshop forums need be convened throughout the ward at various locations main agenda being enlightening the public over national government functions fundable by CDF.

2.3.4.10 Way forward

Members expressed concern on the restrictive nature of the projects fundable by CDF, as they had some priorities that they were informed not to fall under national government functions.

2.3.4.9 Challenges

The area primary school heads representative urged for creation of conducive learning environment in their schools on matters of health hygiene. He called upon a data bank over the schools in need of toilets/latrines facilities. He also called upon the schools' heads for sustainability of what is readily available within their schools as a number of schools have neglected their maintenance works and wholly relying on the constituency funds.

2.3.4.8 COMMENTS BY THE PRIMARY SCHOOLS HEADS REPRESENTATIVE

The meeting was attended by several area of elders from distinct villages within Igwamiti ward whereby they had one voice and reiterated of advantage of several chiefs camps available to the nearness of the citizen. This has eased security as various cases have been legally solved in the chiefs offices. They communicated of their gratitude over improvements observed over the roads within their areas that have eased entrepreneurs reaching their markets of concern.

- Invited guests/stakeholders

2.3.5.2 PREAMBLES

Every meeting started with a word of prayer from the location chiefs who later welcomed the distinguished guests and lauded the importance of the meetings in constituency development.

2.3.5.3 COMMENTS BY THE DEPUTY COUNTY COMMISSIONER

He communicated his remarks by saying that rural development programs are integral in improving the lives of people in the rural settings. Therefore, this programme should be put at the top of the national agenda by the government. Hence encouraged that the community should be good stewards of the CDF to promote development in their areas.

2.3.5.4 COMMENTS BY THE FUND ACCOUNT MANAGER

He highlighted that CDF only funds community-based projects meant to serve community needs in the constituency and have long-term positive effects on people's wellbeing and also gave a briefing on the ineligible projects. He further asserted Co-funding is also allowed where a project can be financed from sources other than the Fund so long as the other financiers or donors of that project have no objection and provided that the part funding for the project availed pursuant to the CDF Act 2013 shall go to a defined unit or any part thereof or phase of the project in order to ensure that the particular portion defined in the allocation is completed with the funds allocated under this Act.

2.3.5.5 COMMENTS BY THE CDFC CHAIRMAN

He pointed out that the impact of CDF cannot be underrated in transforming people's lives in the country. In the education sector, CDF funding of schools has assisted in increasing student enrolment, the CDF bursary has helped retain in schools' students from low income families. Hence, the public should champion for the protection and retention of the fund as much as possible.

2.3.5.6 COMMENTS BY THE AREAS CHIEFS.

2.3.5.7 COMMENTS BY THE SUB COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER

He encouraged for creation of workshops in our schools to enlighten the pupils, students and teachers and any other institution members over various safety health hygienic topics that includes:

- precautionary medicine problems
- Recognizing groups at threat for specific preventable diseases
- Coordinating the resources of health care institutions, social service organizations, public safety personnel, or other agencies to enhance the community health.
- Designing or use monitoring tools, like screening, lab records, and vital information, to recognize health risks.
- Developing tools to address behavioral causes of diseases.
- Assessing the effectiveness of recommended risk reduction actions or other interventions.

2.5.5.8 CHALLENGES

Members complained over a short time notice to the meeting whereby they were not fully flexible to gather their priorities from a widespread area of the members of the ward boundaries.

2.5.5.9 WAY FORWARD.

It was proposed to be put into consideration that public members are engaged in a number of activities for their living. Thus ample time to be given for preparations and adjustments of their day to day activities.

2.4 CHALLENGES

- Communication breakdown in that; the public participation timelines are short and inadequate for preparation.
- Cultural practices challenging meetings proceeding.
- It was noted that there is overreliance on CDF funds by the community.
- Lack of awareness from the public on the nature of projects done by NGCDF
- Lack of interest by the public members over the participation forums
- Hostility- members who lack proper understanding turn hostile to each other, thus disrupting the meeting.
- Facilitation issues- community members asking to be facilitated to attend the forum
- Language barriers

2.5 WAY FORWARD

- I. Timely release of the notice of such meetings.
- II. The NAC/DFC to conduct civic education to the members of the public on the various roles of the NAC/DFC and its priority areas.
- III. More development forums to make the public aware with information concerning the development initiatives, from various funding projects.
- IV. Use of interpreters
- V. Community education of their roles in public participation forums

2.6 CONCLUSION

- Members appreciated the exercise as it gave them a sense of place to the projects done by the NAC/DFC. The meetings resolved that ongoing projects shall be given precedence, to fast track their utilization to enable the beneficiaries get value for money.
