## **INTRODUCTION**

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is a fund established in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the CDF Act 2003. The Act was later reviewed by the CDF (Amendment) Act 2007, and repealed by CDF Act, 2013 which was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2016.

The Fund is domiciled within the ministry in charge of national economic policy and planning, currently the Ministry of Devolution and Planning. The main purpose of the Fund is to enhance infrastructural and socio-economic development at the grass root level in order to reduce poverty by dedicating a minimum of two and half per cent (2.5%) of all National Government's share of annual revenue towards community projects identified at constituency level by the communities.

The fund is managed by National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board (NG-CDF Board) established under Section 14(1) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act, 2015. The NG-CDF Board is the organ responsible for the overall management of the Fund at the National level. It ensures that administration of the fund is done efficiently and effectively.

NGCDF Committee is established under section 43(1) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2015. The Committee is mandated to administer the fund at the constituency level. Key responsibilities are to identify projects, allocate funds to projects, and disburse the funds to project implementation committee, monitor the implementation of the fund and report to the NGCDF board.

**Kuresoi South** is a constituency in Kenya. It is one of eleven constituencies in Nakuru County. Kuresoi South includes four electoral wards:

1. Amalo Ward
2. Keringet Ward
3. Kiptangich Ward
4. Tinet Ward

It borders Molo, Kuresoi North constituencies. It has an area of approximately 583 sq km<sup>2</sup>. The constituency has an estimated population of 115,435 and 55,661 registered voters.

## **Projects**

In the last financial year (2021/2022) the NG-CDF allocation was Kshs. 137,088,179. The funding was distributed to education, environment and security sectors among others. Since the funds were not disbursed on time to the constituency account, 85% of the projects funded were not complete.

#### **Chairperson's Remarks**

The chairman welcomed all for the meeting, introduced the team of CDFCs and also urged everyone to observe covid 19 protocols. He thanked the area chief and assistant Chiefs for the support they are giving in the implementation of the NG-CDF projects in the area.

#### **FAM's Remarks**

He noted that Section 27 (1) of the NG-CDF Act 2015 as amended in 2016 requires that the chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall within the first year of the commencement of new Parliament and atleast every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters.

The FAM explained on eligible and ineligible projects under the Act. He also sighted section 49 of the NG-CDF Act where part funding is allowed other than the fund. He also noted as per section 46 (2) of the Act priority will be given to ongoing projects. He informed the public the Projects to propose should be related to Education, Security, Environment and Sports.

#### **Area Member of Parliament Remarks**

He thanked the community for electing him and promised to work together with other elected leaders in delivering the development agenda of Kuresoi South Constituency. The Member of Parliament told the communities benefiting from the projects to be vigil and provide social audit on those project. He however asked the project management Committees to provide returns once the project is complete and be accountable to each and every coin funded to the project. He vowed to complete all projects he initiated and asked the CDFCs to proper monitoring and evaluation of the projects and to adhere to procurement procedures.

### **Challenges**

The community suggested the major challenges was infrastructure of the schools within the ward. They cited lack of laboratory in their secondary school affected the quality of education in the area. They also highlighted that most secondary school have few TSC Teachers and urged the Member of Parliament to intervene on their behalf to the ministry of education.

#### **Fund Account Manager Remarks**

The FAM started by introducing the NG-CDF Committee. The FAM explained the following National Government functions which are eligible for funding:

#### **Chairman's Remarks**

He also advised the PMCs to shun corruption on projects and make sure projects are completed in the stipulated amount of time.

#### **Area Member of Parliament Remarks**
