The committee agreed that it was necessary to ensure that all new constructed classrooms are equipped. They also agreed the all the renovations done were perfect. They therefore agreed that all renovations should include, roofing, ceiling and tile works.

#### Clarification on varied costs of the projects

#### KIMANI NGUNJIRI PRIMARY SCHOOL/KENDURUM PRIMARY SCHOOL AND MENENGAI HILL PRIMARY SCHOOL

During the implementation of the projects, the PMC realized that the ground level was not even and therefore the contractor was required to raise foundation than expected therefore putting a high cost on implementation.

#### KIMANI NGUNJIRI SECONDARY SCHOOL

The Project was 1st funded by NGCDF Bahati in financial year 2018/19 at a cost of 1,200,000 which was used to lay foundation for two no. classrooms. The 1st phase was completed and after the PMC invited the structural Engineer he rerouted the staircase which was earlier placed in between two classrooms and was suggested that the stairs be placed at the end of the classrooms. This would mean that the classrooms were expanded and extra works were done to relocate the staircase works. This would however increase the cost of project from 8,000,000 to 10,000,000.

#### KIAMAINA ICT CENTRE/MULTIPURPOSE HALL

The ICT Centre was supervised by the NCA Engineers and the Regional Structural Engineer. They identified some shortcoming on the building because the span of the hall was wide and the pillars would not support the upper building. The Engineer advised that more pillars be constructed and since the building was also fixed with a ramp whose gradient would not serve people living with disability accordingly, therefore they gave a fresh BOQ for the completion of works and remedial works leading to variation.

#### About NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty. The fund is managed by the Constituencies Development Fund Board (CDFB).

Since 2003/04, the Fund supported projects mainly in the areas of education, health, agriculture, roads, security, environment and sports. However, the NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2016 introduces a major shift in the scope of projects eligible for funding. Under this Act only projects falling within the functions of the National Government as outlined in the Constitution of Kenya will be funded. This effectively means that moving forward, the Fund will concentrate primarily on education, security, sports, environment sectors and other national government residual functions

The National Government CDF committees develops project proposals in consultation with wananchi through periodic ward level open forums, submits them to the NG-CDF Board for approval and facilitates the PMCs in the planning, implementation, and sustenance of the projects once completed

The project Management committees and the NG-CDF committees collaborates for efficient project management through technical support of relevant government department within the sub-county
