The chairman called the meeting to order at 9:00am. Opening prayer was by Margaret Wanjiru. The chairman welcomed all the members, especially the public and congratulated them for making it on time and agreeing to the exercise of public participation, which is the only place where development in the constituency can be achieved as per the public needs and demands. The chairman then introduced the guest by asking each and every one of them to introduce themselves, by stating their names, what and which organizations they represent. The chairman then asked the secretary to read the previous public participation exercise report and asked that everyone in the public participation be given a copy of the report for their perusal.

The secretary read the previous public participation report, and asked the fund account manager to take the forum through projects approved, and implemented after public participation in September 2021. The funds account manager gives the status of all implemented works as per the approved code list FY 2020/2021 and 2021/2022. He gave a comprehensive statement on project implemented; their status as at the time of this public participation, projects approved and funds yet to be disbursed as well as those whose approvals are still pending. The funds account manager, further expressed gratitude on cooperation and technical advice from line Ministries Such as public works, administration office (office of the president) And the education department.

The funds account manager then gave an overview of the role of NGCDF as a National government development agent. The fund account manager, Reminded the forum, that after the promulgation of the new constitution 2010, the national government was left with only two major functions that is, security and education. In this case education referring to infrastructure in primary and secondary schools and issuance of bursary. He advised on proposals being directed towards the two national government functions.

He also explained that, Public participation exercise is done every two years, therefore, proposals should be projected and expected to be implemented in the next two years. He advised on patience as the procedure to approval, May not be as fast as expected. He explained

that once the public gave their proposals the NGCDF committee will prioritize and send the proposals to the board. The board evaluates according to the two government functions and approve the proposals for implementation upon release of funds.

The chairman then asked the forum to welcome the area member of parliament Hon David Gikaria, as the moderator for the day and explained that being at the constituent's representative he was better placed to moderate the exercise. The Member of Parliament welcomed everyone to the public participation exercise, and asked them to feel free to express their opinions. He encouraged the Public that this was their day to express themselves give their views and propose any development they feel is important in the constituency for the benefit of the whole community.

Hon David Gikaria, Also thanked the community for voting him back in as their member of parliament for another five years. He said that he would not take it for granted as the trust the public has in him is immense since he is serving his third term as Member of Parliament for Nakuru town east. The Member of Parliament informed the public that he remembers he also made promises during campaigns and that he would deliver all his promises based on constituency development and the interest of the community and vowed to work with the community for the betterment and development of all of us.

The MP emphasized on the ongoing projects that would first be finished before embarking on any other new projects started, and added that the ongoing project had already been allocated a total of 29 million shillings for their continuity to completion and that the committee would prioritize new projects based on the balance that remains after deduction of statutory expenditure.

The Member of Parliament also insisted on respect of each others opinion and giving everybody enough time to express themselves but the forum must be time conscious as the exercise is not supposed to take a long time. Having not much to say the area Member of Parliament proceeded to the plenary session where he moderated and the proposals were as follows,
