MIN 75: 10/08/2023: PROJECTS PROPOSAL BUDGET FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2023/2024

The Chairperson br efed members that the committee is required to submit project proposals for the financial year 2023/2024 in time to get funds, the fund account manager told members that the NG-CDF Committee is supposed to submit projects proposals to the NG - CDF Board as per the guidelines of the National Government projects. The members also discussed the health risks the asbestos pause to the pupils in school and hence agreed to fund the schools that have prioritised removal of asbestos from classrooms.

The Fund Account Manager informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of Kshs.175, 361,810.00 The Fund account manager briefed members on the guidelines for project proposal presentation and also informed members on the eligible projects. The manager informed members that all devolved functions are no longer eligible under the new NG-CDF act.

After lengthy deliberations the NG- CDF committee agreed on the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2023- 2024 in all the four wards in the Constituency. Due to limited space in most school in Nakuru town East the members agreed to allocate adequate funds to put up strong foundation while constructing classrooms which can later be reinforced to accommodate other classes on top as a storey building. All bill of quantities are attached for both construction of classrooms.

The secretary read the previous public participation report, and asked the fund account manager to take the forum through projects approved, and implemented after public participation in September 2021. The funds account manager gives the status of all implemented works as per the approved code list FY 2020/2021 and 2021/2022. He gave a comprehensive statement on project implemented; their status as at the time of this public participation, projects approved and funds yet to be disbursed as well as those whose approvals are still pending. The funds account manager, Further expressed gratitude on cooperation and technical advice from line Ministries Such as public works, administration office (office of the president) And the education department.

The funds account manager then gave an overview of the role of NGCDF as a National government development agent. The fund account manager, Reminded the forum, that after the promulgation of the new constitution 2010, the national government was left with only two major functions that is, security and education. In this case education referring to infrastructure in primary and secondary schools and issuance of bursary. He advised on proposals being directed towards the two national government functions.

He also explained that, Public participation exercise is done every two years, therefore, proposals should be projected and expected to be implemented in the next two years. He advised on patience as the procedure to approval, May not be as fast as expected. He explained that once the public gave their proposals the NGCDF committee will prioritize and send the

The MP emphasized on the ongoing projects that would first be finished before embarking on any other new projects started, and added that the ongoing project had already been allocated a total of 29 million shillings for their continuity to completion and that the committee would prioritize new projects based on the balance that remains after deduction of statutory expenditure.

The Member of Parliament also insisted on respect of each other's opinion and giving everybody enough time to express themselves but the forum must be time conscious as the exercise is not supposed to take a long time. 



Kenya Forest Service appreciates partnership with NG-CDF Nakuru Town East through a Framework for Collaboration. This comes in the wake of the Special Presidential Forestry and Rangelands Restoration programme that aims at accelerated achievement of 30% tree cover by 2032.

Stakeholder engagement and partnerships are key elements towards achievement of this programme. The framework for collaboration hinges on a platform of strategies to deliver the restoration programme, which proposes multiple interventions. The NG-CDF has the obligation to restore 10Ha of Bahati Forest and 10Ha of Menengai Forest, which the Service will avail.

The framework is expected to help grow a total of 22,000 tree seedlings over an area of 20ha of forest land calculated at an espacement of 3m x 3m, translating to approximately 1,100 tree seedlings per ha. Through such efforts, the production of 15 Billion tree seedlings towards achievement of 30% tree cover by 2032 can easily be realized.

In this regard, Kenya Forest Service is happy to have this partnership with the NG-CDF Nakuru Town East constituency to support rehabilitation and restoration of degraded forest areas as stated in Article 2 of the Framework, read together with Article 5.




