**PRELIMINARIES**

The meeting started with prayers led by Mr. Samwel Naikada. The chair welcomed the members to the meeting and asked them to be ready to deliberate on the meeting's agenda. The chairman asked all members present to wear their masks and social distance at least two meters.

**MIN 01/09/2021. CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:**

The secretary read through the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes were proposed to be the true copy of the deliberations held by Isaac Musunkui and seconded by David Kariuki.

**MIN 02/09/2021: KILGORIS NG-CDF PROJECTS PROPOSAL BUDGET FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2021/2022**

The Chairman briefed members that the NG-CDF Board had send a circular No. NG-CDF/CEO/BOARD Circulars Vol.II(030) dated 26<sup>th</sup> August,2021 for allocation and forwarding of the project proposals for the financial year 2021/2022 with Kilgoris constituency set to receive **ksh. 137,088,879.00** including standard emergency of ksh. **7,192,207.00** The deadline for submission of the project proposal set by the NG-CDF Board was **30<sup>th</sup> September, 2020**. In arriving at the final list board gave priority to the ongoing projects in compliance with the Act, project reports from the ward meetings, constituency strategic plan and equity.

After lengthy deliberations the NG - CDF committee agreed on the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2020 –2021 in all the six wards in the Constituency. All ongoing projects were also allocated funds for completion. The board also resolved should they discover any other ongoing project on the ground left out, it will be factored in financial year 2022/2023.


In response to mitigating Covid 19 pandemic more funds were allocated to construction of classrooms and water tank projects, for classroom the estimated is pegged at ksh 1.4 million by Ministry of Public Works. This figure is justified by the unique challenges affecting the constituency. Firstly, Kilgoris forms the farthest part of Narok County. The area is only accessible through Bomet and Kisii Counties, therefore supply of materials is a challenge as quarry stones either come from Narok Town or Thika and lorries have to comply with weighbridge laws. Secondly, the area has poor road network which also add to the cost of transporting materials. Most roads were destroyed during the March/April 2020 rains and in some instances there are no roads to project sites. Since some projects like Nailare primary school are not accessible the contractor is forced to do the road to the project at their own cost or deliver material to a place where the road ends and from there hire/carry with a tractor /trailer which is additional cost not factored. Thirdly, the area has black cotton soil and therefore, a lot of reinforcement is required during construction so the structure is not compromised thus this increases the cost. Fourthly, the size of our classroom is the twenty-five by thirty feet which is large. And lastly some areas their topographical nature is very sloppy as the contractor have to do foundation (sub-structure courses) even up to ten courses and this also increase the cost of construction.

The board also resolved to do ninety-six capacity dormitory with ksh. 6.5million and 45 Capacity laboratory with ksh. 6.5million. Any project not allocated adequate funding for completion in the current financial year the NG-CDFC commits to complete the project in the following financial year of 2022/23 or the earliest time possible if funds are availed.




