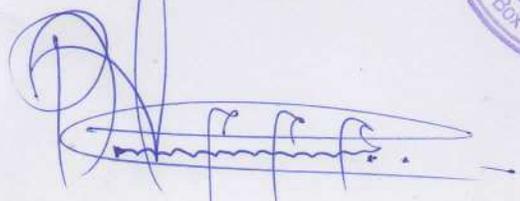

MIN 5/08/01/2024; MOE CONDITIONAL GRANT FOR JSS INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Members were informed that the project proposal for financial year 2023/2024 had been recalled in line with the Board Circular Re: Infrastructure Development for Junior Secondary schools dated 16th October, 2023 and Ministry of Education Circular Re: Infrastructure Development for Junior Schools dated 3rd October, 2023.

NG- CDF Kilgoris Constituency was allocated Kshs.20,003,683 as a conditional grant proposed to be jointly managed by the Ministry of Education and the NG- CDF to ensure synergy and timeliness in implementing the program.

In addition, the allocation was based on grade seven (7) enrolment and as a constituency, the committee is required to match a shilling to a shilling to enable realization of the objective of the program. In order to achieve the matching requirement in the identified JSS Institutions, the table below shows how the allocation is distributed between the two sources of funds:

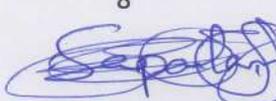
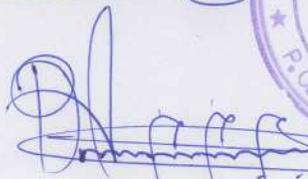

MIN 6/08/01/2024 EX. MIN 2/10/11/2023: ADOPTION OF EDUCATION STAKEHOLDERS' RECOMMENDATION ON IDENTIFICATION OF JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS FOR FUNDING 2023/2024 FY

The chairman tabled the minutes of the Education stakeholders consultative meeting between the NG-CDFC Chairman, the Fund Account Manager – Kilgoris, D.C.C Transmara South, D.C.C Transmara West, S.C.D.E – Transmara West and S.C.D.E – Transmara South on funding of Junior Secondary schools held in the NG-CDFC Boardroom on 26/10/2023 for adoption.

The committee deliberated and unanimously adopted the recommendation of the consultative meeting and resolved to allocate the funds as recommended with each Junior Secondary classroom be constructed to completion at the rate of Kshs. 1,500,000.

The FAM then informed the committee that with the inclusion of the Kshs. 20,003,683 allocated by the Ministry of Education, the constituency allocation had increased to Kshs. 204,133,584 for the financial year 2023/2024. The committee then urged the FAM and chairman to expedite the process of preparation of the budget proposal with consideration of the consultative meeting's recommendations for timely onward forwarding to the NG-CDF Board.

MIN 7/08/01/2024: CONSIDERATION OF ONGOING PROJECTS



The fund account manager informed the committee of the requirement by the NG-CDF Board that on preparation of the constituency proposal, priority should be given to ongoing projects before embarking to new ones. It was however noted that the constituency had only one project ongoing by closure of the financial year (i.e. construction to completion of ACC's office at Enoosaen), which had been done to completion by the time the project proposal was being drafted with the allocation for the previous financial year leaving the constituency without a single ongoing project to consider in this financial year's proposal. The structure is currently complete and in use and the same would be adequate to host the ACC. Thus, the committee proposed all new projects as herein.
