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INTRODUCTION

ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty. The fund is managed by the Constituencies Development Fund Board (CDFB).

In January 2013, the CDF Act 2003 (as amended in 2007) was repealed and replaced with CDF Act 2013 that is aligned to the constitution of Kenya 2010.

The enactment of the CDF Act 2013 was mainly aimed to ensure that the law governing CDF is aligned to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of:

- ✓ Transparency and Accountability,
- ✓ Separation of Powers
- ✓ Participation of the People.

The new law was also aimed to align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure. The CDF Act 2013 was repealed in 2015 to conform to the functions of the national government. Currently there is the NG-CDF Act 2015 which deals specifically with functions of the National Government.

There's a new amendment which is The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (Amendment) Act, 2022. The major reasons for the amendments are to enhance equity in sharing of the fund across the country.

BURETI

Bureti Constituency is one of the 6 constituencies in Kericho County; it covers geographical area of sq km (Approx) 321. Bureti has a population of 199,470 people as per 2019 census. It is mainly inhabited by the Kalenjin communities. Farming is the main economic activity in the constituency. The constituency has 7 wards namely;
