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MIN.02. NG-CDFC/17/01/023: WARD CONSULTATIVE REPORTS

The FAM tabled the report on the proceeding of open public meetings/ward consultative report. The meetings were held across the constituency on 9th and 12th of January 2023 within the four wards of the constituency. The report gives a detailed priority projects that the community wishes the Sigowet/Soin NG-CDF to undertake in the FY 2022/2023 and 2023/2023

The committee heard that the open public meetings was meant to allow the public participate in the development agenda of the constituency as a key constitutional principle and as provided by section 27(1) of the NG-CDF Act 2015.

The committee deliberated on the report and made the following comments

- (i) There were so many ongoing projects that require to be completed.
- (ii) The community had prioritized many projects among them were devolved functions. This demonstrates that there were so many challenges affecting the community. There was therefore need for partnership and multisectoral approaches to tackle the challenges affecting the community
- (iii) There was need to educate the public on division of functions between the two levels of governments that is the National Government and County Government.
- (iv) There was need to explore methods of engaging the youth, women and PWDs in the development agenda.

The committee delved at length on this report and adopted it for use as a guide for development in the constituency for the next two years. The report was proposed by Miss. Irene Cheruiyot and seconded by Mr. Andrew Soi.

The ward consultative report therefore forms part of official Sigowet/Soin NG-CDF document. The committee members after lengthy deliberation on ward report, unanimously resolved to prioritize ward projects as follows;



The FAM read through the requirements as stated on the circular and the budget allocation of Kshs. **138,215,033.00.** He mentioned on key requirements such as adhering to Strategic Plan, adhering to the statutory ceiling, giving priority to ongoing projects, Covid 19 Response projects and adhering to the ward report. Introduction or Background

0.0 About NG-CDF

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is a fund established in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the CDF, the CDF Act 2003. The Act Was Later reviewed by the CDF (Amendment) Act 2007, and repealed by CDF Act, 2013 which was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2016.

The Fund is domiciled within the ministry in charge of national economic policy and planning, currently the ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The main purpose of the fund is to enhance infrastructural and socio-economic development at the grass root level in order to reduce poverty by dedicating a minimum of two and half percent (2.5%) of all National Government's share of annual revenue towards community projects identified at constituency level by the communities.

The Fund is managed by the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board, which is a body corporate with perpetual succession and common seal. The Board operate at national level, and comprises of Board of Directors and a secretariat.

The enactment of the CDF Act 2013 was mainly aimed to ensure that the law governing CDF is aligned to the constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of:

- Transparency and accountability,
- Separation of powers; and
- Participation of the people.

The new law was also aimed to align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure.






