2.0 The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) formerly Constituencies Development Fund (CDF), is a fund established in 2003 through an Act of Parliament, the CDF, the CDF Act 2003. The Act was later reviewed by the CDF (Amendment) Act 2007, and repealed by CDF Act, 2013 which was subsequently succeeded by the current NG-CDF (Amendment) Act 2016.

The Fund is domiciled within the ministry in charge of national economic policy and planning, currently the Ministry of treasury and Planning.


The main purpose of the fund is to enhance infrastructural and socio-economic development at the grass root level in order to reduce poverty by dedicating a minimum of two and half per cent (2.5%) of all National Government's share of annual revenue towards community projects identified at constituency level by the communities.

The Fund is managed by the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board, which is a body corporate with perpetual succession and common seal. The Board operates at national level, and comprises of the Board of Directors and a Secretariat.

The enactment of the CDF Act 2013 was mainly aimed to ensure that the law governing CDF is aligned to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, specifically in compliance with the principles of:

- Transparency and accountability,
- Separation of powers; and
- Participation of the people.

The new law was also aimed to align the operations of the Fund to the new devolved government structure.



## 2.About Sotik Constituency

Sotik Constituency was created in 1997.It was curved out from Chepalungu and Bureti constituencies. It has a population of about 167289 as per the 2009 census. It borders Konoin and Bomet Central Constituencies

to the east, Chepalungu and Emurwa Dikir to the South Borabu to the west and Bureti to the north. Its main economic activities are two: Dairy and tea farming. Tea is grown in the highlands i.e Kapletundo ward, part of

Rongena /Manaret ward, part of Chemagel ward,part of kipsonoi ward and in Gelegele location of Ndanai /abosi

ward. The lowlands of Ndanai/abosi Kipsonoi and Rongena /manaret are endowed with good dairy farming. Infact Sotik KCC one of the few milk factories in the county is in Sotik Constituency.The sitting MP Hon Amb Francis Sigei is serving his first term.
