

### Comments by the Fund Account Manager



## Comments by the Fund Account Manager

The Fund Account Manager explained to the Consultative Public Participation meeting the purpose of the meeting that as for the Amended Act the law required that the NG-CDFC Chair must hold a Public Participation meeting every two years to deliberate and identify Projects to be funded by NG-CDF. This helps the NG-CDFC Fund Projects that the locals themselves have identified and hence the input of the community was very crucial.

- The Fund Account Manger said that with the introduction of devolution and hence county Governments certain projects which were previously funded by NG-CDF were classified as County Projects and hence can only be funded by County Government. Such projects include Water, Health Centres and Roads Projects. He therefore requested that while the Public is considering Projects to be funded in their areas they don't include such County Projects.
- The Fund Account Manager therefore advised that the Public consultative meeting focuses on Projects that can be funded by NG-CDF Board only. The Projects to be funded by NG-CDFC includes Projects in Education Sector such as schools and institutions infrastructure, building of classrooms, laboratories, dormitories, administration blocks and Toilets or Pit latrines. He also advised that renovations of the existing infrastructure to make them better and durable can be funded.
- On the Security Sector the Fund Account Manager explained that NG-CDF can fund construction of Police Posts to enable the Security Sector operate better.
- On Environment the Fund Account Manager advised the Public that NG-CDF can fund a forestation and also can put up Public Toilets to ensure clean and conducive environment.
- The NG-CDF can also fund sports in schools by purchasing footballs, netballs, volleyballs, uniforms and other sports equipments and also support local community teams and tournaments' he however emphasized that they cannot fund individual cash awards.
- The NG-CDF can also fund construction of infrastructure such as offices and Purchase of land for offices for the Deputy County commissioner, Assistant County commissioners, Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs to enable such officers serve the community better from decent offices.
- The Fund Account Manger told the gathering that NG-CDF Board is also able to fund TVET
  Colleges and Kenya Medical Training Colleges infrastructure since those two areas fall under
  National Government functions.
- Lastly the NG-CDF Board can also fund in a significant way Bursary to needy bright student from Malava Constituency. He therefore advised the Public that while deliberating they should focus on those areas.

 The NG-CDFC Chair introduced all the NG-CDFC Members and staff and encouraged the Public Consultative meeting to deliberate freely and ask any questions on all areas they feel like so that they can make informed contributions to the consultative meeting.


