### NGCDFC /MIN. 001/1/2023: PRELIMINARIES

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9.55 a.m. with a word of prayer from Mrs. Ann Mwenyekombo. The chairman welcomed members to their second meeting and thanked them for keeping time. The chairperson requested the members to do self-introduction. The members did self-introduction.

## NGCDFC /MIN. 002/1/2023: READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the secretary which were confirmed by Mrs. Juliet A. Ofwera and seconded by Mr. Antony Makuto as a true record of the previous meeting.

NGCDFC/MIN. 003/1/2023: ALLOCATION OF AIE NO. B185209

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The manager tabled AIE number B185209 of Kshs. Seven Million (7,000,000.00). The members deliberated and agreed to allocate Kshs. Two Million (2,000,000.00) for administration and Kshs. Five million (5,000,000.00) for bursary to needy school going students.

### NGCDFC/MIN. 004/1/2023: ISSUANCE OF BURSARY FORMS

The Fund manager informed members that production of bursary forms was on course in readiness for commencement of issuance on 13th January, 2023. Members discussed and agreed that forms would be issued to members of the public by NGCDF committee members in collaboration with chiefs at the venues and dates in accordance with the advertisement.

## NGCDFC/MIN. 005/1/2023: ONGOING PROJECTS (KMTC AND CHEBUYUSI HIGH SCHOOL)

The Fund Account Manager tabled a status report on KMTC- ongoing construction of administration block of 30 offices. The project is about 85% complete and needs Kshs. 7,183,216.80 for completion. The chairman further informed the members that the first lot of students will be reporting in March 2023 for classes and therefore need for fencing of the 9.6 acres of the institution land. The members discussed and agreed to allocate Kshs. 4,000,000.00 only due to lack of enough funds and further agreed to allocate the balance of Kshs. 3,183,216.80 in the budget proposal for 2023/2024 financial year.

The Fund Account Manager further tabled a report on the status of ongoing construction of 45 capacity 4 no. classrooms and a staffroom of 10 capacity on 1st floor of existing ground floor storey building. The members discussed and agreed to fund Kshs. 3,500,000.00 and further committed to allocate the balance of Kshs. 1,461,014.80 in the financial year 2023/2024 for completion.

The Fund Account Manager informed the members that the report that was submitted to the NGCDF Board on ongoing projects did not include Sivilie Primary School - Completion of 3no. Classrooms due to clerical error. The committee discussed and resolved to allocate Kshs. 600,000.00 to the project for completion. They further agreed that the ongoing report be amended and resubmitted to the NGCDF Board for consideration and approval.

## NGCDFC/MIN. 006/1/2023: DELIBERATIONS OF WARD PROPOSAL REPORTS

The chairman thanked members for the active role they played during the ward public participation meetings which were held from 3/01/2023 -5/01/2023 at Chief's office grounds in line with the notice for ward public participation across the five wards. He reminded members that through such exercise, the committee would be able to understand the needs of the constituents unlike many years ago when a committee could decide for them. Since the funds could not finance all the proposed projects, the NG-CDF Act allows the committee to utilize the wards report for two financial years before going back to the constituents for fresh proposals. After lengthy deliberations, the committee settled on the following proposals for funding in this current financial year, 2022/2023:

### BACKGROUND

### ABOUT NGCDF

The Constituencies Development Fund was created by the Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2003 with the primary objective of addressing poverty at grassroots level by dedicating a minimum of 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue to grassroots development and the reduction of poverty. The fund is managed by the Constituencies Development Fund Board (NGCDFB). In January 2013, the NGCDF Act 2003 (as amended in 2007) was repealed and replaced with NGCDF Act 2013 that is aligned to the constitution of Kenya 2010. However, the NGCDF act 2013 was repealed and replaced by Nation Government Constituencies Development Fund Act (NG-NGCDF) 2015 after the High Court Ruling of 20th Feb 2015 that declared the NGCDF Act 2013 unconstitutional hence invalid. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-NGCDF) is under the ministry of Devolution and Planning. The objective of the fund is to provide mechanism for supplementing implementation of the National Government development agenda at the constituency level.

### ABOUT NAVAKHOLO CONSTITUENCY

Navakholo constituency alias Navakholo Sub County is one of the twelve constituencies in Kakamega County. It is a rich agricultural area with continuous rainfall and rich agricultural soil. The main cash crop is sugar cane farming. Most roads are seasonal with a few all-weather roads. The main mode of transport is motor vehicles along the main roads and motor cycles that ply the interior of the Sub County.

According to the 2009 population census report, the total population of people in the constituency is 137,165 out of which 98,453 live below the poverty line (KNBS, 2009) making it among most populated constituencies in Kenya. There are 84 Primary and 28 Secondary schools in the public sector as well as 7 Primary schools in the private sector. The school structures range from semi-permanent buildings made of mud walls and timber to permanent buildings. 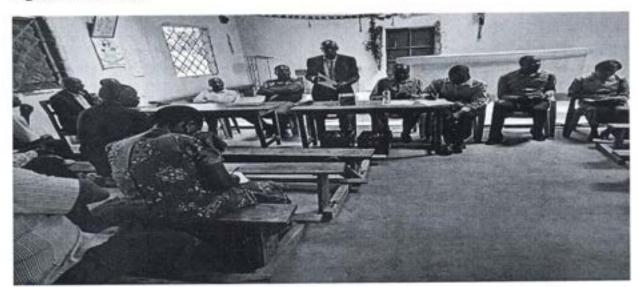
