#### INTRODUCTION

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was set up under the CDF Act, 2003, repealed by the CDF Act, 2013 and now NG CDF (Amendment) Act 2015. The NG CDF is represented by the Cabinet Secretary for Devolution and Planning, who is responsible for the general policy and strategic direction of the NG CDF. The objective of the fund to ensure that specific portion of the national annual budget is devoted to the constituencies for purposes of infrastructural development, wealth creation and in the fight against poverty at the constituency level.

Mumias West Constituency is located in Kakamega County bordering Mumias East, Matungu and Butere constituencies. It has an approximate area of 1652 Km with population of approximately 111,862. It has (4) four county assembly wards namely Mumias Central, Mumias North, Musanda and Etenje.






