MAT/NG-CDF/MIN 11/21/02/2019: CDFC ALLOWANCES

FAM informed members that with the available funds members should do bursary vetting immediately in readiness for disbursement.

The committee authorized the bursary subcommittee to start the vetting exercise immediately for 5 days. Members then authorised the FAM to process allowances of 9 CDFC members at Kshs. 5,000 each.

Members were also informed that a select committee of eight members from the Sub County had been dentified to meet and deliberate with the Kibabii University Board to establish a Campus in Matungu constituency.

Similarly the committee approved the processing of transport and lunch allowances for the team of officials to visit Kibabii University to negotiate the development totalling Kshs.50,000. Action FAM

MAT/NG-CDF/MIN 12/21/02/2019: CHANGE OF ACTIVITIES AND RESUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR 2018/19 FY

Members were informed that the Board adjudicated on 2018/19 FY CDF proposal and APPROVED all projects EXCEPT for a few that had logistical issues to be cleared first.

The deferred projects were;

- **1.** Namanga Primary School-Completion of 2 classrooms- NGCDFC to specify completion activities and separate cost of two activities
- **2.** Namalasire Primary School-Completion of ongoing renovation works on 4 classrooms-NGCDFC to specify completion activities of the ongoing renovation.

The declined projects were;

- **1.** Makunda Secondary School- Purchase of school Bus Co-funded with PA- NG-CDFC to allocate adequate funds to ensure one off purchase of the bus because schools are no longer allowed to take loans nor raise funds through PA contributions
- 2. Matungu TTI Construction of office and construction of tuition block The Constituency is not among those identified by the Ministry of Education Science and Technology in the third phase of the co-funding for construction of TTIs

After lengthy deliberations, members agreed to make the following changes on the project proposal:
