MIN. 01/11/2018: OPENING REMARKS

The Chair called the meeting to order with a word of prayer from Mrs. Hellen Munzala at 10. 26 A.M. Thereafter he welcomed the members to the meeting and thanked them for keeping time. The Chair made several remarks and the following points were noted;

 The Chair informed the meeting that the NGCDF Board had released the Constituency allocation table and that all the constituencies had been allocated an equal amount of KShs 109,040,875.52 for the financial year 2018/19 as per the NGCDF Act, 2015.

2. The Chair also informed the meeting that he was aware of the outstanding claims by members and urged the Fund Account Manager to dispose of the matter as soon as its

possible. In addition, the Chair also informed the committee that the current Sub County Accountant Mr. Eric Okoth Ochuka had been transferred and that we ae awaiting for his replacement.

MIN. 02/11/2018: CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

The Secretary took the meeting through the previous meeting minutes held on 14th August, 2018. Thereafter the minutes were confirmed as that day's deliberation after it was proposed by Mr. Hillary Agoi and seconded by Mrs. Hellen Munzala.

MIN. 03/11/2018: MATTERS ARISING

Vide Min 03/August/2018: The Chair informed the meeting that the intended visit by the CEO-NGCDF Board never materialized due to the ongoing National Examinations exercise.

Vide Min 6/August/2018: The Fund Account Manager informed the meeting that Lusui AP Camp project had been constructed, however the police officers cannot be posted to the camp since they were no a readily available source of water for their domestic use.

Vide Min 8/August/2018: The Chair informed the meeting that the Contract renewal for Mr. Chrisantus Abakala- The Clerk of Works had been made as resolved.

MIN. 04/11/2018: APPROVAL OF PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR THE FY 2018/19

The Fund Account Manager informed the meeting about the guidelines that were issued by the NG-CDF Board to guide the committee in the preparation and submission of project proposal for the financial year 2018/19. The following points were noted:

a. Ikolomani Constituency was allocated a total of KShs 109,040,875.52 for the financial year 2018/19, this is the same amount allocated to all the 290 constituencies.

b. Projects to be considered should be the ones that fall under the functions of the National Government in the constitution and that priority should be given to orgoing projects.

- c. The proposal should be reflective of the wards consultative report that had been conducted earlier.
- d. The committee is expected to adhere to statutory ceilings for certain types of projects which included; Administration & recurrent costs (6%), Emergency reserve (5%), Sports activities (2%), Environmental activities (2%), Monitoring & Evaluation (3%), Social Security programmes, education bursary Schemes, mock examinations and continuous assessment tests (35%).
- e. Constituencies are advised to set aside funds to facilitate preparation of the constituency strategic plan.

Subsequently the Fund Account Manager tabled the report for ongoing projects from various wards proposing the projects to be funded for discussion by the committee. Thereafter they were a lengthy deliberation on the same and the following points were noted;

- a. A total of KShs 45,050,875.52 was proposed to be set aside for the purpose of statutory allocations. This meant that a balance of KShs 63,990,000.00 was available for allocation to development projects.
- b. The committee further agreed that no new projects will be funded a part from the development of a constituency strategic plan, this was to ensure that all ongoing projects are funded adequately for their completion.

After considering the proposals tabled and putting into consideration a number of factors in mind the committee resolved to approve for funding the following projects;
