4. **MIN. 1: EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/01-MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS.**

The fund manager sought approval of pending bills more allowances for the previous NG-CDF member after successfully concluding the hand over. After deliberations from members, they unanimously approved for their payment.

5. **MIN. 2. : EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/02-APPROVAL OF THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION REPORT**

The Fund manager presented the report from the recently concluded public participation report that were held on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2023. The members deliberated on the report and unanimously agreed to adopt and used it the allocation of the project funds to the FY 2022/2023 Budget proposal.

The projects were identified across the constituency from the three wards namely; West Bunyore ward, Central Bunyore ward and North East Bunyore ward as listed below.

6. **MIN. 3. : EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/03-FLAGSHIP PROJECTS**



The meeting recommended following projects to be established across the constituency as part of flagship projects:

- **ESSUNZA PRIMARY SCHOOL**

The institution hails from Central Bunyore ward and the committee recommended establishment of one storey block which consist of 7 No. classrooms and administration office i.e. Ground floor will accommodate 3 No. classrooms and administration office while 1<sup>st</sup> floor will accommodate 4 classrooms. The meeting resolved to fund the project in three consecutive financial years as a result of the total amount of the project. This implies that project will be executed in phases. Allocation approved for the FY 2022/23 (1<sup>st</sup> phase) was **Kshs. 5,000,000.00**.

The following activities will constitute the 1<sup>st</sup> phase, that's substructure works which will includes; excavation of the foundation trench, casting of the footing, construction of the foundation wall, hand packing of hard core, blinding and casting of the floor slab, Superstructure works; erection of columns.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of this project will attract a total balance of kshs.16; 707,870.00this amount will be spread in the next consecutive financial years consecutively.

- **EBUYALU SECONDARY SCHOOL**

The meeting deliberated on the above institution and its needs. It's from west Bunyore ward, Going through the Public Participation Report considering the limited space available for infrastructural expansion. The committee recommended establishment of one storey building consisting of 4 No. classrooms at 1<sup>st</sup> floor, 1 No. dining hall(capacity of 160 persons) and a waiting area, two offices and staffroom. The committee resolved to allocate Kshs.5, 000,000.00 during the 1st phase, in 2022/23 F/Y. The following activities will be covered in phase 1; casting of the footing, construction of foundation wall, hand packing of hard core, blinding, and casting of the floor slab and erection of columns.

The amount balances (kshs.17, 510,770.00) as per B/Q will be budgeted in the next two consecutive financial years.

- **BUNYORE BOYS SECONDARY SCHOOL**

In North East Bunyore ward, the meeting recommended construction of one floor storey building to contain classrooms, laboratory and administration office. The total estimate (as per the B/Q) of this project is kshs.23, 750,405.00 Ground floor will consist of 4 No. classrooms, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor will contain 2 No. laboratories (with a capacity of 45 students each) and 1 No. administration office. The committee on its deliberation approved the project to done in three phases. The 1st phase has been allocated Kshs.5, 000,000.00. It will contain the following activities; excavation of foundation trench, casting of the footing, construction of foundation wall, hand packing of hard core, blinding, and casting of floor slab & erection of columns.





Further the committee members have committed to budget for the remaining funds (Kshs.18, 750,405.00) in the next two consecutive financial years.

**7. MIN. 4. : EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/04-ONGOING PROJECT; EMUHAYA MAGISTRATE COURT**

The committee noted the following while budgeting for Emuhaya Magistrate court:

- Planning for this project started on 2019/2020 F/Y as per budgets proposals. However, the project physical implementation started on 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2022. The delay was occasioned as a result of change of design from judiciary and late approval of the project by the NGCDFB. The NGCDFB recommended various changes to the documentation of the project.
- In view of the above, it's of concern to the NGCDFC of Emuhaya that if the project is funded fully in this financial year as recommended, then other projects equally of priority will lag behind.
- Therefore, in the NGCDFC's deliberations, it is making a request in kind for consideration on this matter to be allowed by the NGCDFB to allocate Kshs. 9,000,000.00 in 2022/2023 F/Y and the balance of Kshs.12, 377,476.33 to be fully allocated in 2023/24 F/Y for completion of the project.

**8. MIN. 5. : EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/05-EMUHAYA CONSTITUENCY ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION PLAN**

The committee resolved to be enjoined with government of Kenya in providing a National Environmental frame work to finance climate adaptation and mitigation measure.

In view of above, the committee will form a Constituency Environmental Conservation PMC. The Sub-County Environmental Officer will be an ex-official member of the PMC and will be the technical of this project.

The major mandate of PMC shall be establishing of nursery seedlings and lay out plan for redistribution for planting to government institutions, water conservation zone like hills and riparian land. The other mandate shall be to clear unwanted trees near water catchment zone. The PMC shall guarantee safety and sustainability of seedlings and trees planted with the guidance of Sub County environmental Officer.

The NGCDFB listed and approved the following seedlings among others to be developed for planting; Fruits trees (Avocados, mangos, passion), gravellearobusta, pine, cedar, elgon tick, macadamia lutea, bamboo and podocarpusfalcatus.





On other hand, the meeting listed and approved the following area for consideration that will benefit from seedlings as regards to planting the trees: Alupeku Hills, Riparian land along Mungecha to Emmabwi, Esibila Boys secondary school, Bamboo trees along Mulwang'ombe, wacholo, Ebbusamba, musella and Mwilulu village, Emuhaya sub-county police headquarter offices' compound and Ematsuli Assist chief office compound

10. **MIN. 7: EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/07 CO-FUND;PURCHASE OF 51 SEATER SCHOOL BUS AT MWITUHA SECONDARY SCHOOL**

The meeting learnt from the quotation that the cost of acquisition of the 51 seater school bus had gone high up to Kshs.8, 768,000.00 unlike last year when the costs were at Kshs. 7,500,000.00. Therefore the meeting resolved to budget Kshs. 7,500,000.00 towards the same and the school's Board of Management agreed and committed to fund the balance of Kshs.1, 268,000.00 for fully acquisition of the Bus.

11. **MIN. 8: EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.03/08 :CO-FUND;ESIBILA BOYS SECONDARY SCHOOL**

The committee having visited the school, when it submitted its proposal for consideration. The members were shown site for laboratory and for classrooms. The committee observed that the terrain to horst laboratory was hilly and rocky while for classrooms looked is fairly level.

Therefore the meeting resolved to allocate Kshs. 2,500,000.00 for construction of a 50 capacity laboratory i.e. Kshs. 500,000.00 extra to allocation as result of the terrain. The allocation of a classrooms remained at Kshs. 900,000.00 since site shown was fairly level for construction to completion.

The county security team visited for last year around July, for completed Emuhaya Sub-county police head quarter office in preparation for possible hand over. The members of the security team including the County commissioner, County police commandant and the entire sub-county security headed by Deputy county commissioner.

The committee confirmed that the project was complete but recommended the following before taking over:

- Casting of suspended slab at all the cells namely male, female and juvenile.
- Re-carpeting of the floors with tiles

The committee resolved to allocate Kshs. 1,800,000.00 for execution of the mention activities as advised by an officer from Department of public works, Vihiga County.



13. MIN. 10: EMU/NG-CDFC/MIN.01/07-TRAINING/ CAPACITY BUILDING OF NG-CDFC & STAFF

The Fund Manager informed the meeting that the plans for intensive training and capacity building of the NGCDFC and staffs are underway. He therefore requested the Chairman and the Secretary in consultation with other members to come up with a suitable date for the training.

**1.0 NG-CDF**

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2015 requires that, the chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall, within the first year of commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency. The last ward Consultative meeting for Emuhaya Constituency was held during 2021/2022 F/Y. In view of the foregoing and taking cognizance of the fact that this is the first year of the 13<sup>th</sup> Parliament, Fund Account Manager is required to inform chairperson of this requirement and submit authenticated reports on the open forum public meetings alongside the constituency project proposal.

This is also in line with Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya. It aids in identification of priority projects both immediate and long term.

Following the above guidelines, the chairman for Emuhaya National Government Constituencies Development Fund, Fund Accounts Manager & the office of the Emuhaya Deputy County commissioner, agreed to hold ward meetings in all its wards in Emuhaya Constituency.



**1.1 EMUHAYA**

Emuhaya NG-CDFC is one of the five constituencies that fall under Vihiga County. The constituency has three wards namely west Bunyore Ward, Central Bunyore Ward & North-East Bunyore Ward, with a total of seven locations and twenty-five sub-Location. According to the 2019 National Population and Housing Census, the constituency had a population of 97,141.00. It is projected to increase to 111,894 by 2024.

**1.2.0 CENTRAL BUNYORE WARD:**

1.2.1 Central Bunyore Ward has got two locations and eight sub locations. Refer to the table below.

1.2.2. The meeting was held at Tongoi chief on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 as from 10.00am - 2pm. Notification for the meeting was sent out to all stakeholders through the area chiefs, Parliamentary liaisons offices and assistant Chiefs within the ward.

1.2.3 Most of the stakeholders who were invited to the meeting attended, included Emuhaya NG-CDFC, Assistant county commissioner (ACC), Fund Account Manager, NG-CDF staff, chiefs, Assistant chiefs, Principals/Heads of secondary schools, Head teachers of Primary schools, representatives of Youths, women, people living with disabilities and other opinion leaders.

**1.3.0 COMMENTS FROM CHIEFS**

1.3.1 The area Chief David Olocho opened the meeting with a word of prayer from Mrs. Grace Aswani. He welcomed all stakeholders present in the meeting and invited his colleagues from Emakunda Mrs. Ruth Ingosi also to address the audience. Thereafter he invited the NG-CDFC to guide on the exercise.

- 1.3.2 The NG-CDFC chair introduced his team then he explained the purpose of the meeting after getting the guidance from the NG-CDF office through joint chiefs and NG-CDF committee that was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> of January, 2023.
- 1.3.3 He also highlighted the importance of involving stakeholders in the preparation of the Constituency Budget. He outlined the procedures/requirements laid down as per the Act towards preparation of the budget proposal and also the nature of Projects to be highlighted for budgeting in respect to NG-CDF 2015 Act.
- 1.3.4 He also outlined that the Act considered some projects as eligible projects for funding and others not eligible. Why? From his explanation, as per the NGCDFB Act, *“eligible projects are only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the function of National Government under the Constitution, which must be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area. In addition, eligible projects shall be those that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity”*. He also outlined to the stakeholders' examples of ineligible projects. Some examples of ineligible projects read out to the meeting were;
- i. Projects supporting political bodies or activities
  - ii. Projects supporting religious bodies or activities
  - iii. Recurrent costs of a completed project
  - iv. Personal awards with the exception of social security programs and education
  - v. Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to exclusion of others
  - vi. Projects falling under devolved functions. e.g. water, roads & health.
- 1.3.5 The chairperson further made the stakeholder aware of the state of ongoing projects in Emuhaya Constituency and touched on the policy guiding ongoing projects as outlined by the NGCDFB regulations.
- 1.3.6 The stakeholders were also made aware that Emuhaya NG-CDF budget allocation was **Kshs.137, 088,879.00** during 2021/2022 and this financial year Emuhaya NG-CDF has been allocated a total of **Kshs. 131, 342,462.00** for budgeting. This year allocation was based on wards per constituency unlike before where each constituency receive equal share from the NG-CDF Board.

**1.0 NG-CDF**

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2015 requires that, the chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall, within the first year of commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency. The last ward Consultative meeting for Emuhaya Constituency was held during 2021/2022 F/Y. In view of the foregoing and taking cognizance of the fact that this is the first year of the 13<sup>th</sup> Parliament, Fund Account Manager is required to inform chairperson of this requirement and submit authenticated reports on the open forum public meetings alongside the constituency project proposal.

This is also in line with Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya. It aids in identification of priority projects both immediate and long term.

Following the above guidelines, the chairman for Emuhaya National Government Constituencies Development Fund, Fund Accounts Manager & the office of the Emuhaya Deputy County commissioner, agreed to hold ward meetings in all its wards in Emuhaya Constituency.

**1.1 EMUHAYA**

Emuhaya NG-CDFC is one of the five constituencies that fall under Vihiga County. The constituency has three wards namely west Bunyore Ward, Central Bunyore Ward & North-East Bunyore Ward, with a total of seven locations and twenty-five sub-Location. According to the 2019 National Population and Housing Census, the constituency had a population of 97,141.00. It is projected to increase to 111,894 by 2024.

**1.2.0 NORTH EAST BUNYORE WARD:**

1.2.1 North East Bunyore Ward has got three locations and nine sub locations. Refer to the table below.

1.2.2. The meeting was held at Ebusamia chief on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 as from 12.30am-2.10pm. Notification for the meeting was sent out to all stakeholders through the area chiefs, Parliamentary liaisons offices and assistant Chiefs within the ward.

1.2.3 Most of the stakeholders who were invited to the meeting attended, included Emuhaya NG-CDFC, Assistant county commissioner (ACC), Fund Account Manager, NG-CDF staff, chiefs, Assistant chiefs, Principals/Heads of secondary schools, Head teachers of Primary schools, representatives of Youths, women, people living with disabilities and other opinion leaders.

**1.3.0 COMMENTS FROM CHIEFS**

1.3.1 The area Chief Mr. Seth Majani opened the meeting by calling Mr. Rosa Nyakoa to bless the meeting with word of prayer. He thereafter welcomed all to the session. He requested all the stakeholders present introduce themselves.

- 1.3.2 The NG-CDFC chair again started by explaining the purpose of the meeting after getting the guidance from the NG-CDF office through joint chiefs and NG-CDF office that was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> of January, 2023. He highlighted the importance of involving stakeholders in the preparation of the Constituency Budget. He outlined the procedures/requirements laid down as per the Act towards preparation of the budget proposal and also the nature of Projects to be highlighted for budgeting in respect to NG-CDF 2015 Act.
- 1.3.3 He outlined that the Act considered some projects as eligible projects for funding and others not eligible. Why? From his explanation, as per the NGCDFB Act, "eligible projects are only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the function of National Government under the Constitution, which must be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area. In addition, eligible projects shall be those that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity". He also outlined to the stakeholders' examples of ineligible projects. Some examples of ineligible projects read out to the meeting were;
- i. Projects supporting political bodies or activities
  - ii. Projects supporting religious bodies or activities
  - iii. Recurrent costs of a completed project
  - iv. Personal awards with the exception of social security programs and education
  - v. Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to exclusion of others
  - vi. Projects falling under devolved functions. e.g. water, roads & health.



- 1.3.4 The chairperson further made the stakeholder aware of the state of ongoing projects in Emuhaya Constituency and touched on the policy guiding ongoing projects as outlined by the NGCDFB regulations.
- 1.3.5 The stakeholders were also made aware that Emuhaya NG-CDF budget allocation was **kshs.137, 088,879.00** during 2021/2022 and this financial year Emuhaya NG-CDF has been allocated a total of **Kshs. 131, 342,462.00** for budgeting. This year allocation was based on wards per constituency unlike before where each constituency receive equal share from the NG-CDF Board.

After the above remarks the stakeholders were requested to move to respective sub-location for project identification and reconvene for presentation and hand over of the report to NG-CDF official for onward submission.

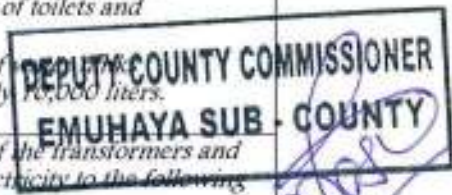

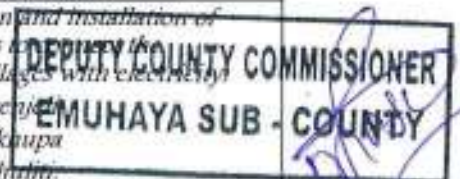

**WEST BUNYORE WARD PUBLIC PARTICIPATION MEETING HELD ON 5<sup>TH</sup>/01/2023 FOR PURPOSES OF PREPARATION OF EMUHAYA CONSTITUENCY BUDGET PROPOSAL OF 2022/2023 FINANCIAL YEAR:**

**1.0 NG-CDF**

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, 2015 requires that, the chairperson of the Constituency Committee shall, within the first year of commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency. The last ward Consultative meeting for Emuhaya Constituency was held during 2021/2022 F/Y. In view of the foregoing and taking cognizance of the fact that this is the first year of the 13<sup>th</sup> Parliament, Fund Account Manager is required to inform chairperson of this requirement and submit authenticated reports on the open forum public meetings alongside the constituency project proposal.

This is also in line with Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya. It aids in identification of priority projects both immediate and long term.

Following the above guidelines, the chairman for Emuhaya National Government Constituencies Development Fund, Fund Accounts Manager & the office of the Emuhaya Deputy County commissioner, agreed to hold ward meetings in all its wards in Emuhaya Constituency.



**1.1 EMUHAYA**

Emuhaya NG-CDFC is one of the five constituencies that fall under Vihiga County. The constituency has three wards namely west Bunyore Ward, Central Bunyore Ward & North-East Bunyore Ward, with a total of seven locations and twenty-five sub-Location. According to the 2019 National Population and Housing Census, the constituency had a population of 97,141.00. It is projected to increase to 111,894 by 2024.

**1.2.0 WEST BUNYORE WARD:**

1.2.1 West Bunyore Ward has got two locations and eight sub locations. Refer to the table below.

1.2.2. The meeting was held at Anyole Radio Station on 5<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 as from 10.00am-12.30pm. Notification for the meeting was sent out to all stakeholders through the area chiefs, Parliamentary liaisons offices and assistant Chiefs within the ward.

1.2.3 Most of the stakeholders who were invited to the meeting attended, included Emuhaya NG-CDFC, Assistant county commissioner (ACC), Fund Account Manager, NG-CDF staff, chiefs, Assistant chiefs, Principals/Heads of secondary schools, Head teachers of Primary schools, representatives of Youths, women, people living with disabilities and other opinion leaders.

**1.3.0 COMMENTS FROM CHIEFS & NG-CDFC OFFICIAL OFFICE:**

1.3.1 The area Chief Mr. Elijah Antibuka opened the meeting by calling one the volunteer to pray. He thereafter welcomed all to the session. He called for introduction from the stakeholders' present. He thereafter hand over to NG-CDF office through its chair to proceed with day's plan.

- 1.3.2 The NG-CDFC chair started by explaining the purpose of the meeting after getting the guidance from the NG-CDF office through joint chiefs and NG-CDF office that was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> of January, 2023. He highlighted the importance of involving stakeholders in the preparation of the Constituency Budget. He outlined the procedures/requirements laid down as per the Act towards preparation of the budget proposal and also the nature of Projects to be highlighted for budgeting in respect to NG-CDF 2015 Act.
- 1.3.3 He outlined that the Act considered some projects as eligible projects for funding and others not eligible. Why? From his explanation, as per the NGCDFB Act, *“eligible projects are only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the function of National Government under the Constitution, which must be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area. In addition, eligible projects shall be those that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity”*. He also outlined to the stakeholders’ examples of ineligible projects. Some examples of ineligible projects read out to the meeting were;
- i. Projects supporting political bodies or activities
  - ii. Projects supporting religious bodies or activities
  - iii. Recurrent costs of a completed project
  - iv. Personal awards with the exception of social security programs and education
  - v. Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to exclusion of others
  - vi. Projects falling under devolved functions. e.g. water, roads & health.
- 1.3.4 The chairperson further made the stakeholder aware of the state of ongoing projects in Emuhaya Constituency and touched on the policy guiding ongoing projects as outlined by the NGCDFB regulations.
- 1.3.5 The stakeholders were also made aware that Emuhaya NG-CDF budget allocation was **Kshs.157, 088,879.00** during 2021/2022 and this financial year Emuhaya NG-CDF has been allocated a total of **Kshs. 131, 342,462.00** for budgeting. This year allocation was based on wards per constituency unlike before where each constituency receive equal share from the NG-CDF Board.

After the above remarks the stakeholders were requested to move to respective sub-location for project identification and reconvene for presentation and hand over of the report to NG-CDF official for onward submission.

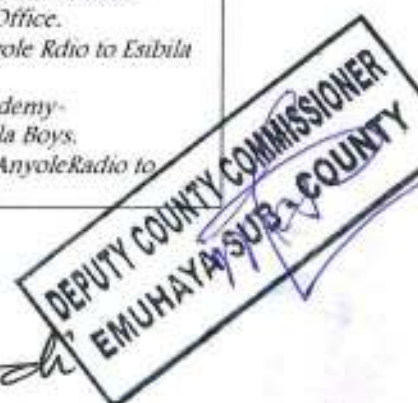




