MIN/04/02/10/2020: DISBURSEMENT OF KSHS. 67,367,724.10.

The chairman informed the committee members about the receipt of **Kshs. 67, 367,724.10** which was on the NG CDF Account for the constituency activities which had been approved in the FY 2019/2020.

The committee members deliberated at length. It was observed that kshs. 27,773,798.00 was pending for bursaries. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, most academic institutions had been shut down. It was resolved that funds meant for the bursaries be reallocated to the needy projects within the constituency. It was also observed that the funds meant for the completion of the DCC residence had not been approved by the board yet. Therefore, Ksh. 2,000,000 had not been received. The members then resolved that the remaining activities be allocated funds as approved and project cheques be drawn immediately for onward disbursement to the projects for the better of the constituency.

Bursaries for the previous financial year had not been utilized as approved due to the Covid – 19 Pandemic which led to the closure of all academic institutions in the country. A total of kshs. 27,773,798 (twenty-seven million, seven hundred and seventy-three thousand, seven hundred and ninety-eight) for both tertiary and secondary education remained unutilized in the FY 2019/2020. Members deliberated at length and resolved that ksh. 27,662,250 (twenty-seven million, six

hundred and sixty-two thousand, two hundred and fifty) be reallocated to the needy projects within the constituency as follows;

MIN/06/02/10/2020: FINANCING OF DCC RESIDENCE

The ACC 1 informed members on the progress of the DCC Residence. He thanked the committee for considering the project to its roofing level. The NG CDF committee had disbursed ksh 2,100,000(two million, one hundred thousand only) for the phase one construction plus ksh. 600,000 (six hundred thousand) for the purchase of land in the FY 2017/2018. The project was initiated by the ministry of interior with a commitment of upto kshs. 1,750,000 (one million, seven hundred and fifty thousand) as per the two AIEs of ksh. 875,000 (Eight hundred and seventy-five thousand) provided. However, only one AIE has been financed by the ministry to date, the amount utilized on the preliminaries, and excavation works. The project cost is ksh. 7,100,000 (seven million, one hundred thousand). The balance to date is kshs 4,125,000 (four million, one hundred

and twenty-five thousand). The ACC 1 requested the committee to consider financing the project to completion. Members deliberated shortly and agreed to support the project accordingly given that they had already supported it initially. They advised the FAM to provide the Board with the required documents to enable the release of the ksh. 2,000,000 (two million) allocated in the FY 2019/2020 meant for the phase 2 of the project; Ring beam, roofing and shutters. Phase 3 which involves finishes; plastering, painting, flooring, ceiling board to be considered in the financial year 2020/2021.

MIN/07/02/10/2020: REPLACEMENT OF BURSARY STALE CHEQUES

There was a concern on the bursary cheques issued to needy students in the beginning of the year. The chairman informed members that most of the cheques had not been presented to the school due to the Covid – 19 Pandemic that led to the closure of the academic institutions. Most of them are either stale or almost stale. The members deliberated on the concern and resolved that all cheques returned by beneficiaries should be received by the assistant accountant and be forwarded to the Sub county treasury for immediate replacement so as not to inconvenience the learners.
