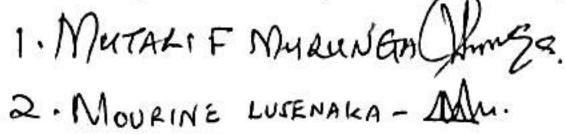

MIN. NG-CDFC: 013/01/2023 - SPORTS TOURNAMENT REPORT

Victor Maruti presented a summary of the Sports tournament. It included the launching which was held on 12th December, 2022 at Panpaper ground, Maraka ward. It was opened by the Area Member of Parliament, Hon. Martin Pepela Wanyonyi in the company of the NG-CDF Board officers led by Madam Elizabeth Kitundu, the NG-CDFC members, The Senator Bungoma County, Area MCAs and other dignitaries. The area MP explained the importance of the tournament and encouraged the youths to participate.

There were two matches that participated during the launch, one for girls and one for boys. The tournament preliminaries were played on 17th and 18th December, 2022. Knockouts for the Girls teams were done on 24th December, Quarters on 26th December, Semi finals and runners up (Girls) done on 28th December 2022. The final games was done on 2nd January, 2023. The two final teams for both girls and boys were awarded trophies, certificates, uniforms, T-shirts, and a token of Kshs. 5,000 bursary from the NG-CDF office.

MIN. NG- CDFC: 016/01/2023 - REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Makemo RC Primary School was funded Kshs. 2,400,000 towards the completion of 3 classrooms reported as initially funded in the 2012/2013 financial year up to roofing level. However, on visiting the school in September 2022 to confirm the status before preparation of documents, it was discovered that there was no such project but a block of condemned classrooms and other very old structures. The school was in dire need of structures and hence, the PMC requested for the NG-CDFC to have the project changed to construction of two new classrooms. Hence, the need for a request of change of project activity from completion of 3 classrooms to construction of two new classrooms to construction of two new classrooms to completion. The Kshs. 2,400,000 is to be used for the construction of the 2 classrooms from Substructure, walling, roofing, fitting of doors and windows and internal plastering. This also called for an addition of Kshs. 600,000 to enable the completion of the classrooms: flooring with terrazzo floor finish, painting works and branding.

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MIN. NG- CDFC: 17/01/2023 - PROJECT PROPOSAL FOR 2022-2023 FYR

There were various reasons that the committee based on to decide on prioritizing the projects to fund and the amount :-

- Lugulu PAG Primary School has two blocks of three classrooms each which were stalled due to: - A) First structure had a challenge of funds allocation being thinly spread which led to use of community labour and low quality materials. In the final event, the classrooms caught fire in 2021 September.
 - B) The second structure of three classrooms was left unfinished after the contractor absconded site due to lack of enough funds and management wrangles.
- 2) The Price for the construction of one classroom has been raised from Kshs. 1,400,000 in the 2021/2022 Financial year budget to Kshs.1,500,000 due to the inflation in the prices of construction materials in the year 2022.
- 3) The Employees salaries has a balance on account of Kshs. 1,032,833 as at 1st January, 2023 which gathers for three months salary and Kshs. 416,028 on the Staff gratuity which gathers for six months. On the base of this, the committee netted of the funds budget for the respective vote items.
- 4) Allowances: the facilitation is used to not only pay the NG-CDFC but other government officers who will from time to time be involved in the implementation of our projects and activities like departmental heads, national government administration officers and NG-CDFC staffs.
- 5) Makemo RC Primary School The school had been budgeted for Kshs. 2,400,000 to complete the construction of 3 No. Classrooms. However, it was discovered that there was no classroom funded by the NG-CDF which led to the decision to have the change of activity to Construction of 2 No. Classrooms. The project shall now be implemented in the 2022/2023 financial year. Hence, the reason for missing on the ongoing projects list.
- 6) St. John's Savana RC Secondary School was allocated Kshs. 2,200,000 in 2021-2022 financial year to purchase 2 acres of land but failed to take off due to increase in selling prices @ Kshs. 1,450,000 per acre by the available land sellers). Hence the need for an additional Kshs. 800,000.
- 7) Three projects for Bakisa Girls Secodary School, Friends Secondary School Muji and Sinoko Secondary school to be funded in two phases: Phase 1 in 2022-2023 financial year @ Kshs. 10 million and Phase 2 in 2023-2024 @ Kshs. 5 million.
- 8) Proposed Environment projects to the four schools whose land was purchased by the NG-CDF as follows:

a) Bakisa Girls Secondary School - 3.5 acres - 2020/2021. The school has a borehole as a source of water.

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- b) Friends Secondary School Khamoto 3 acres 2020/2021 and 2021/2022. The Primary school which is neighbouring the secondary school has a borehole as a source of water.
- c) Katumi CEB Primary School 3 acres 2018/2019, 2019/2020. The land borders a spring to be used as water source
- d) Sirende SA Primary School 3 acres 2021/2022. The land extends to the river which shall be used as a water source.

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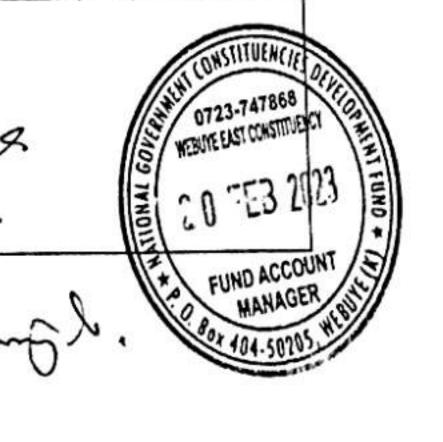

MIN, NG-CDFC: 018/01/2023 - BURSARY APPLICATION

The Fund Account Manager gave a brief report on the ongoing bursary application for both secondary and tertiary students. So far 1,000 students have been keyed in the system. 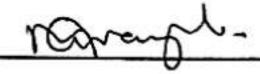

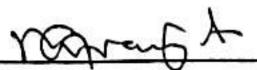

The FAM gave a brief education on matters concerning health because its among the factors affecting the economic development of the constituency and the country at large. She outlined various diseases that has a big challenge to the community such as; HIV AIDS, Cerebral Palsy, Albinism and many more.

HIV stands for Human Immune Deficiency Virus. AID stands for Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome. It affects the immune system of the body(white blood cells) hence reduces the quantity of white blood cells that fights viruses in the body. HIV can be spread in different ways like unprotected sex with infected person, blood transfusion etc. She also talked about the methods of preventing HIV such as;

- a) Avoid unprotected sex with an infected person.
- b) Abstain.
- c) Use of protection i.e condoms
- d) Be faithful to your partner.

The FAM gave an overview of the NG-CDF from its formation up to the its current status. She outlined the projects funded by the NG-CDF and those not funded like health, agriculture, water, county roads etc. The projects funded include Education, Security, Sports and Environment. She outlined that all schools that have been registered by the Ministry of education are the ones that can be funded. The members were educated on the general aspect of the NG-CDF usage. FAM also talked about bursary application for both ongoing students and the new students in secondary and tertiary level. Ongoing students for tertiary to bring fee statement and the previous receipt to the NG-CDF Office as from 27th December to 10th official their January documents and send to email scan (cdfwebuyeeast@ngcdf.go.ke). Ongoing secondary school students should bring a third term report card, fee structure and previous receipt at NG-CDF Offices. Application for new students for both tertiary and secondary school level will done immediately the form ones get admission letters and It will be done at ward level in all the three wards. She then educated members on the meaning and importance of public participation by use of Data collection forms that were given to every person present. Members were given room to make their contributions and ask questions whereby the FAM responded accordingly. 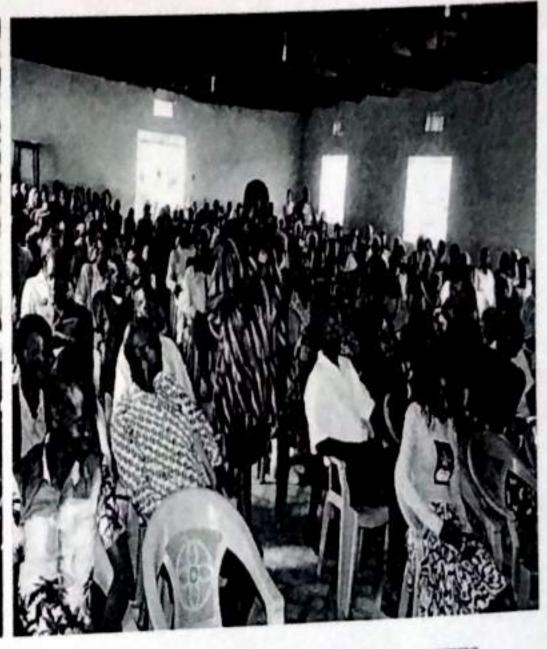

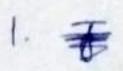




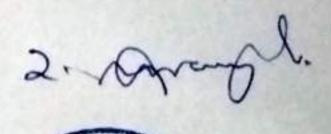
