## Introduction

The members of the Kabuchai NG CDF Committee traversed the Kabuchai Constituency to collect the opinions of the public on the project proposals for the financial year 2022/2023.

## Attendance

The NG CDF Committee prepared a schedule for the exercise as follows;

The chairman of the NG CDF Committee invited members of the public to the public participation in all sessions. He asked the members to practice openness and represent all the divisions accordingly.

The Fund Account Manager thanked all the members of the public for accepting the call by the NG CDF committee to participate in the public participation. She explained to the members the reason for the meeting, and why their participation was important; members were expected to provide information pertaining their relevant wards/divisions without any biasness.

The FAM further explained the need to focus on national government related activities which includes; the Education sector (school projects and bursary), Security (including chiefs and asst. chiefs, electricity, roads), sports (tournaments including PLWD), Environment (trees, water harvesting), and Emergency activities.

The following key points were noted from the members of the public;

1. Environment - There is need to plant trees in all public schools within the constituency. This will provide shade and also work towards achieving the government directive of having enough trees across the country to increase the water catchment for food security.
2. Electricity - Members of the public decried the increasing rate of insecurity across the constituency. They plead to NG CDF to intervene and ensure electricity is spread across as a security measure to reduce theft in homes as a result of darkness.
3. Bursary allocation and distribution - As a cross cutting issue in the constituency, members of the public suggested that, the NG CDF should consider raising the bursary secondary schools allocation from ksh 4, 000 per head to a minimum of ksh. 5, 000 varying to a maximum of Ksh 20,000 depending on the need and the fee structure of the



varying institutions. It was also noted that, there should be a provision for the full scholarships for the most deserving cases to support the education fully.

4. Sports tournament - There is need for a sports clinic the constituency. The stadium should be modified and if possible have a stadium in every ward.
5. Mock and CATS - The NG CDF Committee to support the schools in providing for the facilitation of mocks and CAT to improve the performance of learners because it is too expensive to purchase the exams in schools or by parents.
6. The members asked the NG CDF Committee to assist in the processing of ownership documents for the land purchased for the public institutions.

The ACC Remarks;

The ACC appreciated members for their turning up. "Are you prepared to give your views?" he posed the question in all the forums, and members eagerly responded, "yes". He told the members that the exercise was bring them on board and make them take responsibility of development across the constituency on behalf of many others. He asked the members to exercise openness without any fear and that their views and opinions were very important for the success of the fund.

The ACC used the platform to encourage members of the public to adhere to the government directives. He asked members to utilize the hustlers fund as required, and apply for the subsidized fertilizer through their sub locations.
