NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/01/027/09/021 PRAYER AND INTRODUCTION

The meeting was called to order by the chairman with a prayer from Mary Butasi. He thanked the members and urged them to be precise in their deliberations. The agenda of the meeting was tabled and adopted by members after proposal from Mr Ben Muryasi who was seconded by Esther Simiyu.

NGCDF/WBY WEST/ML/02/027/09/021 READING AND CONFIRMATION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

Minutes of the previous meetings were read by the secretary. The minutes were confirmed by the secretary after the proposal from Dorcas N Muryole who was seconded by Julian Wanyama.

NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/03/027/09/021 MATTERS ARISING

A member sought to know whether the dates of activities in the work plans should be followed as prepared. In response, FAM said that the work plans are just guidelines and the chairman was asked to ensure implementation depending on availability of funds as well as schedule of other activities in the office. Re-allocations are yet to be approved by the National CDF board and FAM is waiting for feedback.



NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/04/027/09/021 BURSARY REPORT

The bursary committee calculated the number of applicants against the available funds. Each student was to get 3600 if all the applicants were to be awarded. Thus the committee had to award a section of the students. The following was the number of applicants;

The total amount awarded was 23,205,200 yet available funds was ksh 15, 000,000. the committee decided to prioritize the total orphans, partial orphans, university beneficiaries as well as the tertiary beneficiaries while the rest were to wait for further funding.

NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/05/027/09/021 WARD REPORTS

The reports from various sub-locations in wards were read by the secretary. Members were in agreement with the reports outlined.

In general, the community members were happy with the work CDF is doing across all the wards in the constituency.

NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/06/027/09/021 MONITORING AND EVALUATION

The progress of Matulo girls secondary school was tabled to members. The project is undergoing roofing awaiting finishes. There was a good quality of workmanship.

However, there was a stand off over the brand of iron- sheets to be used in the project. A team was to be put in place to visit the project and solve the same.

However, there was no change in the M and E progress report of the previous meeting dated 25/8/2021, minute number NG-CDF/WBY WEST/MIN 06/025/08/025.

NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/07/027/09/021 ONGOING PROJECTS STATUS

Khalumuli Primary Sch had an initial funding of Ksh 2,000,000 from emergency of f/y 2019/20 for 3 classes and needs to be completed. The committee had allocated funds to Kuywa Primary school, the offices were completed , the project had been identified as an ongoing project but has now been reported as new since the septic tank will be allocated funds in the current f/y 2021/22. Chengoli primary school, lagulu Fr Secondary School, miendo chiefs office and Sirende ACK had their description reported as completion though they require more funds to complete as per the estimated cost. Sitikho secondary school construction completion of dormitory had erroneously been omitted from the ongoing projects and has now been included for finishing of mechanical works. The committee approved the following ongoing projects as below.

NGCDF/WBY WEST/MIN/08/027/09/021 PROJECT PROPOSAL

The fund account manager read to the committee circular on proposal 2021/22 submissions from NG-CDF Board ref no: NG-CDF B/ CEO/BOARD/CIRCULARS VOL 30 dated 30th August 2021 calling for proposals for FY 2021/2021, the letter required the NG-CDF to submit the proposals for the financial year.

The committee was required to prioritize projects worth Ksh 137,088,879. For the financial year 2021/22. Of the above amount 5% is meant for office administration, emergency is 5%, at most 2% for sports activities, 2% for environment, monitoring and evaluation 3%, bursary at least 25% of the total allocation. Members went through the ward reports, scrutinized the minutes and identified the needs of various institutions, stakeholders and proposed the following projects; The committee funder made an undertaking to complete funding of Sikimbilo primary school storey block with an additional ksh 8,000,000 in the f/y 22/23 for phase 2 of 1st floor completion.

The committee further analysed projects that were ongoing for long and had not acquired title deeds and resolved they be allocated funds to complete:

Sitikho Secondary School had been funded by NGCDF 2014/2015 ksh 1,220,000 f/y 2015/2016 ksh 4,000,000 f/y 2016/2017 ksh 2,000,000 f/y 2017/2018 ksh 450,865 total of Ksh 7670 865 balance of ksh 400,000 to complete the dormitory.

Ndurusia Fry School had been funded 2014/2015- ksh 300,000 f/y 2015/16- ksh 500,000 total of Ksh 800,000 and a balance of ksh 200,000 to complete.

Bunangeni primary school had been funded by NGCDF 2015/2016 Ksh 620,000 and requires a balance of ksh 150,000 to complete title deed process,

Bitaya Primary School had been funded Ksh 1,000,000 in 2015/2016 and requires ksh 200,000 to complete processing title,

Moyokwe Secondary School had been funded Ksh 1,125,000 and requires Ksh 300,000 to complete title deed processing.

The Committee further revised the estimate of 6 classes storey block initiated in 2020/2021 by omitting some items in order to have a saving to Ksh 15,000,000 or the contract sum whichever is lower

The committee unanimously approved projects amounting to Ksh 137,088, 879 as below The fund account manager was requested to forward to the NGCDF board for consideration and approval.

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1.0 INTRODUCTION

The NG-Constituency Development Act 2015 stipulates in part 5 section 27 subsection 1 and 2 that the chairperson of the NG-CDFC shall, within the first year of the commencement of a new Parliament and at least once every two years thereafter, convene open forum public meetings in every ward in the constituency to deliberate on development matters in the ward and in the constituency.

The NG-CDFC shall then deliberate on project proposals from all the wards in the constituency and any other projects which the Constituency Committee considers beneficial to the constituency, including joint projects with other constituencies, consider the national development plans and policies and the constituency strategic development plan, and identify a list of priority projects, both immediate and long term, out of which the list of projects to be submitted in accordance with the Act shall be drawn from.

Citizen participation in project planning, management and implementation planning requires the involvement of concerned stakeholders. This includes identifying public concerns and values and developing a broad consensus on planned initiatives. It is also about utilizing the vast amount of information and knowledge that stakeholders hold to find workable, efficient and sustainable solutions

Public participation encompasses a range of procedures and methods designed to consult, involve, and inform the public to allow those that would be potentially affected by a decision or policy to have input into the process. Community participation motivates the stakeholders to work together, recognize the benefits of their involvement and own the projects in their localities

Stakeholders play a central role in setting up priorities and objectives of development initiatives in order to ensure relevance and appropriateness. It is important that

all stakeholders are involved in the development of projects and not just direct beneficiaries of an initiative.

1.1 ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the CDF Act of 2013. In 2013, the CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act,

NG-CDF Act, 2015. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the Ministry of Devolution and Planning.

The Constituency Development Fund (CDF) was introduced in Kenya in 2003 with the passage of the CDF Act 2003 by the 9th Parliament of Kenya which was repealed in 2013 by the CDF Act 2015. The CDF Act provides that the government set aside at least 2.5% of its ordinary revenue for disbursement under the CDF program.

The fund was designed to support constituency-level, grass-root development projects. It was aimed to achieve equitable distribution of development resources across regions and to control



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imbalances in regional development brought about by partisan politics. It targeted all constituency-level development projects, particularly those aiming to combat poverty at the grassroots and entrench equitable distribution of development.

The objective of the Fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government development Agenda at the constituency level.

The CDF program has facilitated the putting up of new water systems, health and education facilities in all parts of the country, including remote areas that were usually overlooked during funds allocation in national budgets.

Webuye West Constituency is an electoral constituency within Bungoma County; the constituency is number 222 out of 290 constituencies in Kenya.

Webuye West Constituency was created in 2013 after Webuye large was split into two; Webuye East and Webuye West.

Webuye West constituency has four wards namely: - Bokoli Ward, Misikhu Ward, Matulo Ward and Sitikho Ward.
