MIN 4 KIM NG-CDFC-MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

- i. On bursary authentication and awarding, it was agreed that the very needy applicants viz total orphaned, the very poor be considered for that at all level-secondary schools, colleges and universities.
- ii. The ward (MCA's) officers be consulted before awarding to avoid double benefit.
- iii. People with disabilities be considered.

- iv. A list of applicants per school within the constituency be proposed for relevant information before final vetting. People who frequently visit and congest the office be given first priority.

The chairman welcomed members to the meeting and thanked them for the good work they had been doing. He informed members about the allocation table that the office had received for the financial year 2022/2023. 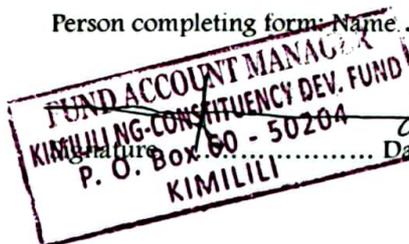

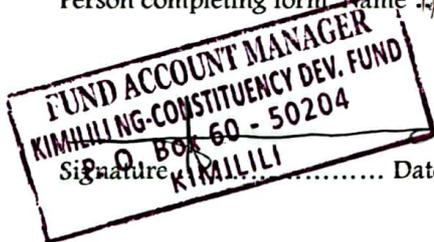

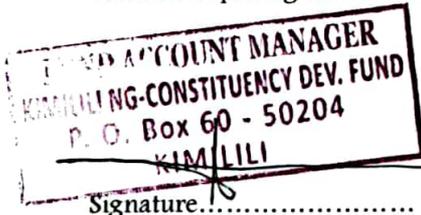

0.1 About CDF

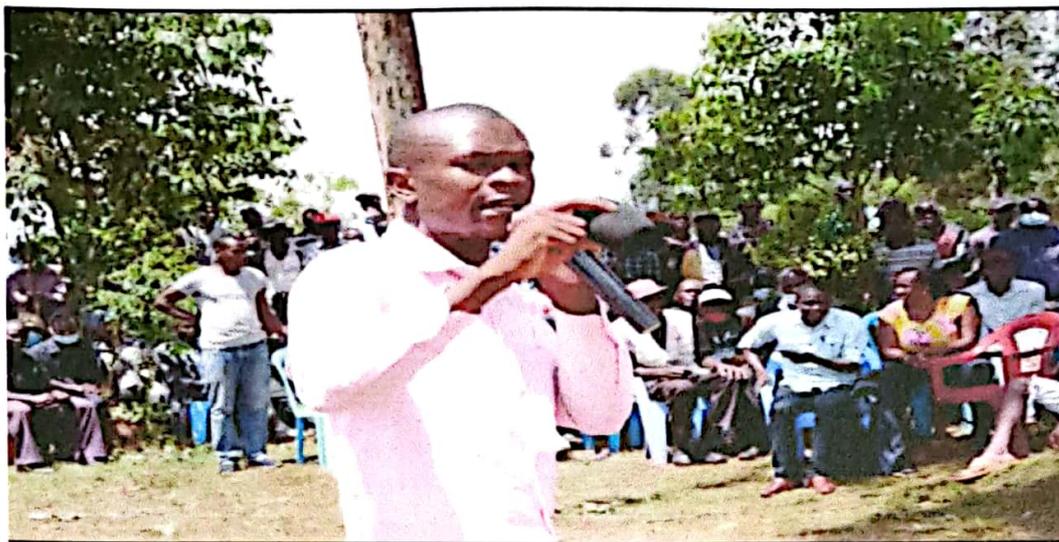
