I.0 National Government Constituencies Development Fund

The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act 2015 as amended in 2016 establishes the Fund as a kitty consisting of monies of an amount not less than 2.5% (two and a half per centum) of all National Government's share of revenue as divided by the annual Division of revenue Act enacted pursuant to Article 218 of the Constitution.

Further, Section (6) of the Act provides that:- *"The board shall, with the approval of the relevant Committee of the National Assembly, allocate Funds for every Constituency in each financial year in accordance with Section 34"*.

Section 34 in turn provides that:- "The budget Ceiling for each Constituency shall be the amount specified in Section 4(1) divided equally among all Constituencies subject to the provisions of Section 8(1) and 23(1)".

ELIGIBLE AND INELIGIBLE PROJECTS UNDER THE ACT

- As per section 24 of the NG-CDF Act as amended in 2016, eligible projects are only those that are in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government under the Constitution, which must be community based in order to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area. In addition, eligible projects shall be those that foster sustainable development, promote human dignity and protection of the marginalized as per Article 10 of the Constitution on national values and principles of governance.
- Constituency Committees shall exclude project proposals that do not meet the eligibility criteria under the NG-CDF Act such as:
 - a) Projects supporting political bodies or political activities.
 - b) Projects supporting religious bodies or religious activities.
 - c) Recurrent costs of a completed project.
 - d) Personal awards with the exception of social security programs, education bursary, mock examinations and continuous assessment tests.
 - e) Projects targeting a specific club or group of people to the exclusion of others.
 - f) Projects addressing devolved functions as outlined in the fourth schedule of the constitution.



ALLOCATION CRITERIA

The NG-CDF comprises of an annual budgetary allocation equivalent to at least 2.5% of the Government ordinary revenue.

- A maximum of 5% is allocated to NG-CDF Board for administrative services.
- A maximum of 95% is allocated to Constituencies based on the following formula;
 - a) 5% of the 95% is allocated to emergency reserve.
 - b) 75% of the balance is allocated equally amongst all the 210 Constituencies
 - c) Balance of 25% is allocated based on the Constituency Poverty index modeled by the Ministry of Development and Planning.

CHALLENGES THAT NEED TO BE ADDRESSED

- Poor project implementation due to low capacity of the committees (NG-CDFs and PMCs).
- Low community participation, which leads to implementation of projects that are not aligned to their needs.

- Spending of funds to too many projects – this is caused by lack of proper planning.
- Funding of new projects without considering on-going projects.
- Cases of issuance of completion certificates for poorly implemented projects.
- Inaccurate monitoring and evaluation of CDF projects by Civil Society Organizations.
- Negative publicity.

Tongaren National Government Constituency is one of the 9 Constituencies of Bungoma County. It borders 5 Constituencies namely: Kimilili Constituency, Kiririni Constituency, Webuye East Constituency, Lugari Constituency, Likuyani Constituency

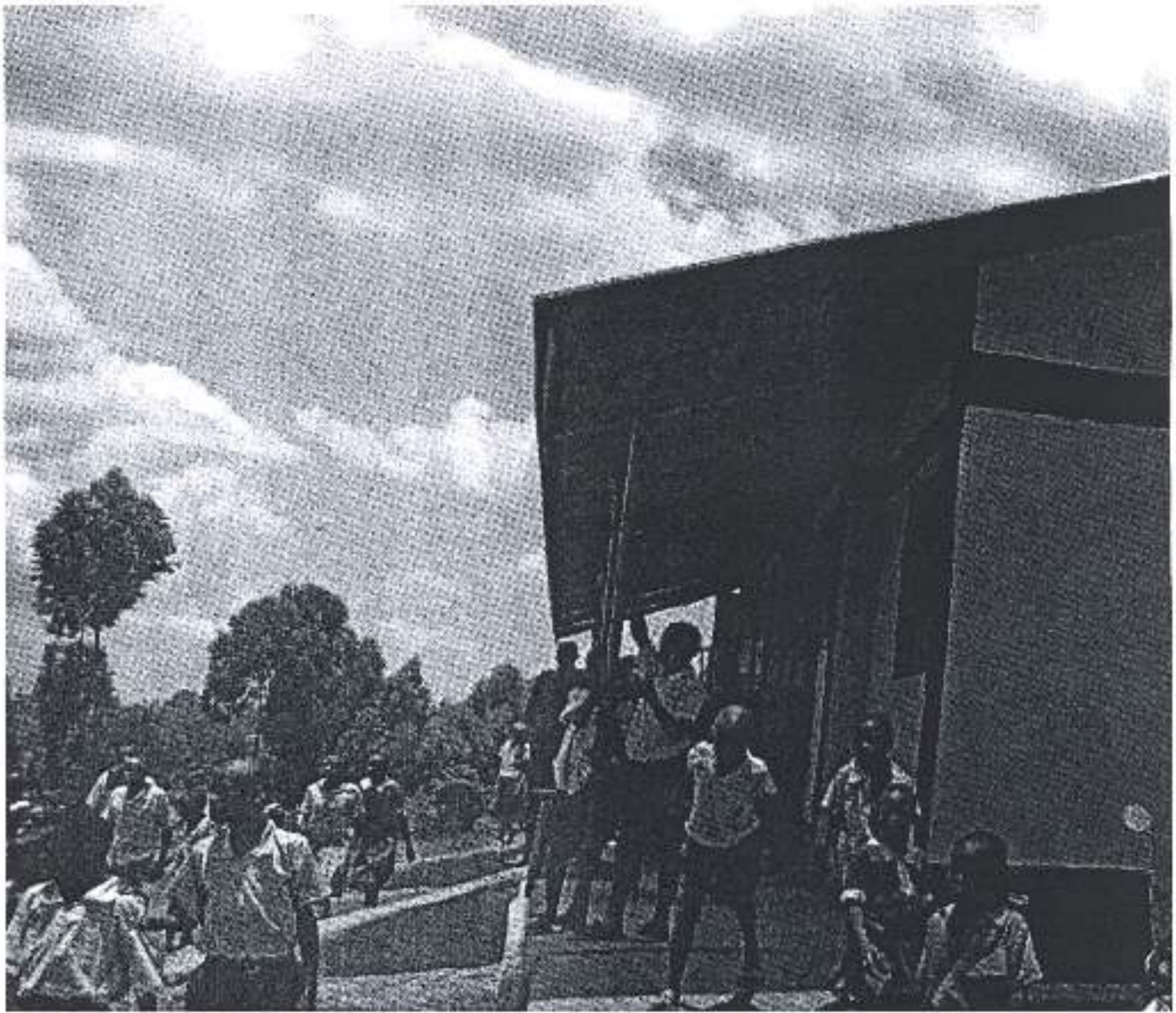
