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1. BACKGROUND

1.1. ABOUT NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund was established in 2004 following the passage of the CDF Act, 2003 by the Parliament. This Act has been amended through the years to improve the management of the fund and was later repealed once the CDF Act, 2007 came into being. Later the CDF Act, 2013 also came into being just before the 2013 General Election, whose main aim was to align the CDF to the New Kenyan Constitution that had been promulgated in August, 2010. A new Act, the NG-CDF Act, 2015 which repealed the previous Acts was passed in 2015 to better align the NG-CDF to the dictates of the new constitutional order as settlement of a Court case which sought to abolish the CDF in its entirety. The main objective of the NG-CDF remains is to alleviate poverty at the grassroots, using 2.5% of government ordinary revenue allocated to it, and disbursed equally to the 290 constituencies, however eligible projects are those in respect of works and services falling within the functions of the National Government listed in the Constitutions Fourth Schedule.

1.2. ABOUT UGENYA NG-CDF

The Ugenya CDF from when it was established in 2004 up to 2013 covered the entire larger Ugenya constituting the present Ugunja Constituency, and covered a total of 11 locations. With the spitting of the constituency by the Boundaries commission, Ugenya remained with Six (6) Locations, later amalgamated into Four (4) Wards, namely;

1. North Ugenya Ward. (North Ugenya Location)
2. East Ugenya Ward. (North East & East Ugenya Locations)
3. West Ugenya Ward. (North West & West Ugenya Locations)
4. Ukwala Ward (Ukwala Location).

In 2004 the first allocation to the constituency was Kshs. 6 million in the 2003 /2004 Financial Year. This has grown consistently to Kshs. 102 million in the 2014 / 2015 Financial Year and to the current Kshs. 138,215,033 in the current financial year as follows;

A huge percentage of the fund (65%) was channeled towards the Education Sector, particularly the construction of classrooms and provision of Education Bursaries. This Allocation is followed by Health projects which take up 20% , mostly used to upgrade health facilities and the balance is used for Security, Roads, Environment and Roads projects.

With the promulgation of the constitution in 2010 and the formation of the counties after the 2013 General elections, the Ugenya NG-CDF has refocused its attention to exclusively funding projects falling under the National Government Functions. A majority of the funds (65%) continues to be channeled towards the education sector with Bursaries taking 25% and the other 40% going to infrastructure projects within the primary, secondary and tertiary institutions within the constituency (Excluding ECD centres and Youth Polytechnics). As Health is a devolved function, an increasing amount of funding (20%) is increasingly going to the Security Sector with housing for officers of the Administration Police Service and Offices for Assistant Chiefs being a priority.

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




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2.1.4. UKWALA WARD

- 2.1.4.1. The Ukwala Ward meeting was held on the Afternoon of Wednesday 4th January, 2023 at the Ugenya Sports Complex Grounds in Awendo starting at 2pm
- 2.1.4.2. Members of the public had been invited through notices posted throughout the constituency as well as on a local vernacular radio station Radio Maiyenya. Heads of Primary, Secondary Schools, Tertiary and religious institutions within the ward had also been invited individually in writing. Members of the County Assembly and the Senator of Siaya County had been invited, they sent representatives.
- 2.1.4.3. The meeting started with registration of all attendees, taking details of their ID Numbers, Telephone numbers and signatures. Thereafter prayers were conducted by a member of the religious fraternity. The Master of Ceremony of the day was The Bursary Chair Mr. Joachim Odhiambo.
- 2.1.4.4. The Chair then took the floor emphasizing the importance of the exercise of collecting views on projects the community wanted to be undertaken. The Chair also emphasized on the importance of the community to apply for bursary during stipulated deadlines.
- 2.1.4.5. The Chair then invited the FAM who gave a brief on the allowable projects under the CDF Act, and also emphasized to the meeting that during this financial year the proposals would only capture projects undertaken by the National Government and leave out projects under the county jurisdiction. The only county projects that would be undertaken would be completion of projects started in the last financial year.
- 2.1.4.6. The MC then started the process of collecting views from the public as to which projects they proposed to be undertaken, as per sub-location, followed by general proposals by other members of the public and opinion leaders. He urged them to use the language they were most comfortable with to make contributions.





3. CONCLUSION



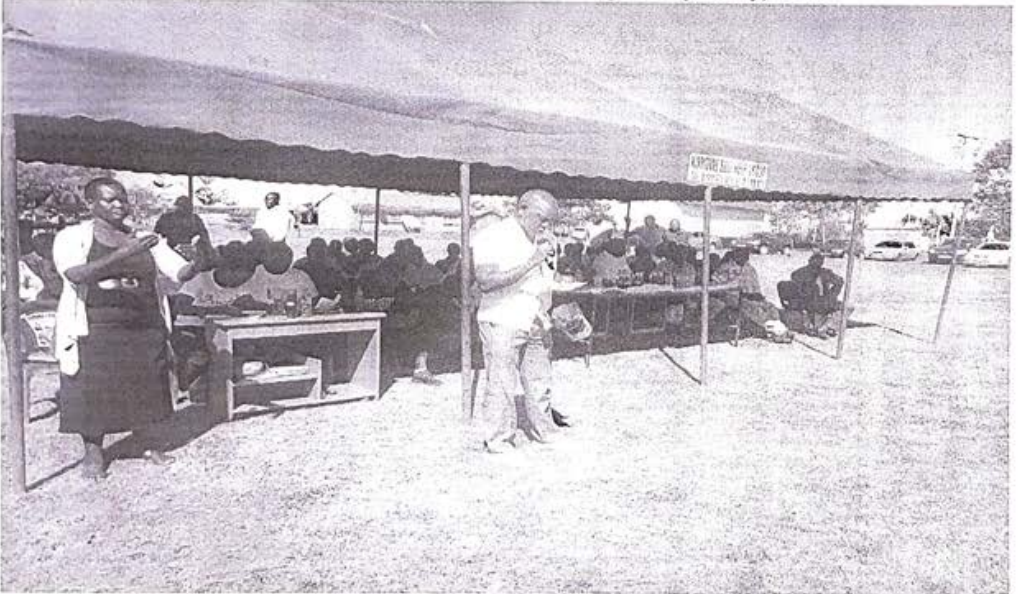

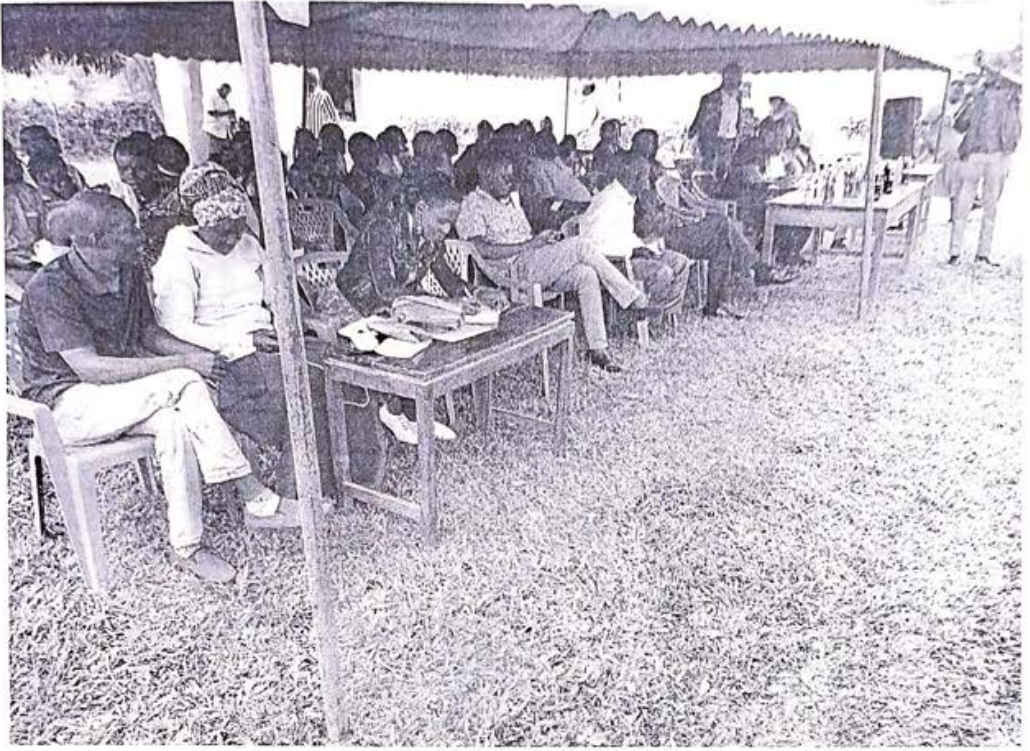

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Min. 01/25/01/2023: PRELIMINARIES.

- 1.1 The Chair called the meeting to order at 10.27am with prayers said by Ms. Everlyne Omondi.
- 1.2 The Chair welcomed members noting that the meeting's main agenda was to prepare proposals for the 2022 / 2023 Financial Year.
- 1.3 The Chair reminded members that the preparation of proposals was one of the most important functions that NG-CDF Committees did on an annual basis and urged them to follow the guidelines issued by the board faithfully so that he would have an easy time making submissions to the Board. He also urged members to think broadly about the projects that were being proposed noting that much as they came from particular wards, they also represented various interests in the community and this was an opportunity to undertake development projects for them.

Min. 02/25/01/2023: CIRCULAR ON THE PREPARATION & SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS FOR THE 2022 / 2023 FINANCIAL YEAR.

- 2.1 The FAM tabled and read to members a circular from the NG-CDF Board Ref: *NG-CDFB/CEO/NG-CDF CIRCULARS/ VOL II (033)* Dated 15th December, 2022 *Titled; PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF CONSTITUENCIES PROJECT PROPOSALS FOR 2022 / 203 FY.*
- 2.3 As the FAM went through the circular, he pointed out very key points as follows
 1. Ugenya Constituency had been allocated Kshs. 138, 215,033 in the 2022 / 2023 Financial Year.
 2. Every two years and particularly at the beginning of a new parliamentary term the chair of the committee shall convene open forum public meetings to deliberate on development matters in each ward. He noted that this had been done on the 3rd and 4th January, 2023.
 3. He noted that all projects proposed by the public and approved by the committee must fall within the National Government functions.
 4. The projects must be community based to ensure that the benefits are available to a widespread cross-section of the inhabitants of a particular area.
 5. The following projects were not eligible under the Act namely;
 - a. Projects supporting political bodies and activities
 - b. Projects supporting religious bodies and activities.
 - c. Recurrent costs of a project.
 - d. Personal awards except under education bursaries.
 - e. Projects targeting specific clubs, society or group of people to the exclusion of others.
 - f. Projects falling under the county government functions as outlined in the 4th Schedule of the Constitution.
6. Projects must receive adequate funding to ensure they are finished within 3 calendar years and funds would be for a defined phase of a project for multi year projects
7. The proposals must adhere to the following statutory ceilings;

8. The FAM further noted that being the 1st year of the parliamentary term, all constituencies were required to allocate funds towards the preparation of a strategic plan which was estimated to cost a maximum of Kshs. 2 million inclusive of publication and launching.
9. The Board had proposed that constituencies prepare to hold county and regional sports tournaments where each constituency was required to set aside Kshs. 350,000 in the current financial year.

next to the school had a succession issue which had taken almost two years to conclude. Now that it was concluded and the owner was ready to sell, he had insisted that land prices had risen markedly over the last two years following the tarmaking of the Ugunja – Ukwala – Nyadorera road which the land was touching. After extensive negotiation they had agreed to pay a further 450,000 to the owner.

6.1 The FAM informed members that this project was due for launching and handover later this year. Now that the admin block and lecture hall complex was nearing completion, there was need for dormitories and abolition locks for the students of the institution to be built.

b) **Ugenya Constituency Industrial Development Centre**

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6.2 The FAM noted that the construction of two sets of workshops was ongoing on the 5 acre site at Bar Anyali and was also due for handover within the year and there was need for a further block of workshops that the Medium & Small Enterprises Authority had recommended to ensure when they brought machinery on site it would have enough space.

c) **Ugenya High School Sports Ground**

6.3 The FAM informed members that the 1st phase which involved leveling of the fields, installation of drainage and fencing was complete, as per the original BQ from the MoPW which was costed at a total of 30 million, the next phase required a dias to built to accommodate 200 spectators.

6.5 The members adopted the FAM's report on the flagship projects for discussion, noting that it was important that the Ugenya NG-CDF implement high impact projects during every financial year.

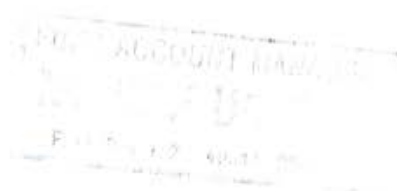

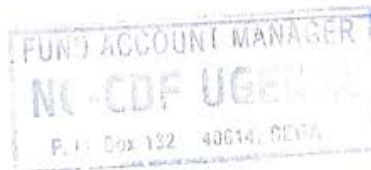
