1.2 About NG-CDF

The Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) was established under the Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act, 2003, amended in 2007 and repealed by the NG-CDF Act of 2013. In 2015, the NG-CDF Act of 2013 was declared unconstitutional and a new Act was enacted in 2015, being the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Act, NG-CDF Act, 2015 also amended in 2022, NG-CDF Act 2022. The National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) is under the ministry of National Treasury and Planning. The objective of the fund is to provide mechanisms for supplementing implementation of the National Government Development Agenda at the Constituency level.

1.3 About BONDO

BONDO is one of the six constituencies in Siaya County.

It has six wards namely: North Sakwa, West Sakwa, Central Sakwa, East Yimbo, West Yimbo and South Sakwa Wards.

The constituency borders Alego Usonga constituency on the north, Gem constituency on the East side, Mbita Constituencies on southern side, Budalangi on the western side.

The main economic activities of the constituents are Farming (both food and cash crop) fishing and Livestock keeping...

The constituency has a population of approximately 197,883, persons as per the 2019 census.

The constituency has an area of 353.2 square kilometers. The dominant economic activity is fishing to areas bordering the lake and farming.

The committee has a number of challenges, the constituency being vast the issue of project monitoring has been difficult. Secondly the constituency has many poor residents hence the applicants for bursary is overwhelming leading to award of little monies to the beneficiaries.

The constituency is cosmopolitan, but the major tribe is the Luos.

Most of the residents of the Constituency are poor and depends on fishing and small scale for their livelihood.

MIN 03/20/09/2022: NG-CDF PROJECTS PROPOSAL BUDGET FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2022/2023

The Chairman briefed members that the committee is required to submit project proposals for the financial year 2022/2023 in time to get funds, the Fund Account Manager told members that the NG-CDF Committee is supposed to submit projects proposals to the NG-CDF Board by the 30th September 2022




The Fund Account Manager informed members that the constituency had been allocated a total of Kshs.151,960,174.00

The Fund Account Manager briefed members on the guidelines for project proposal presentation. She also informed members on the eligible projects. The manager informed members that all devolved functions are no longer eligible under the new NG-CDF Act.

After lengthy deliberations the NG-CDF committee agreed on the following projects to be funded in the Financial Year 2022/2023 in all the six wards in the Constituency

The members were briefed on the guidelines for project proposal presentation as documented by the Circular sent by the NG-CDF Board. Below are the key highlights of the deliberation on items presented to members.

a. Deliberation on Ward Report/Meetings

Having conducted public ward forums between The Fund Account manager tabled before members a summary of the ward report that showed the list of projects considered by the community in each ward. The manager emphasized on the need do more of such public forums to inform the community of the need to ensure adequate project sustainability. Concerns of the community were majorly on Education Security e.t.c.

b. Allocation to Bursary

Members approved allocation of bursaries as per the attached budget. A social security program of Kshs. 3,000,000 was also approved to cater for the vulnerable members in the community under bursaries.

c. Regional Sporting activities

The manager informed the community of a new directive by the Board in the issued Circular to consider participating in at least one regional sport tournament. He also informed members that the regional sports committee come up with a budget of Kshs.350,000 to be contributed by all the constituencies in Siaya County towards facilitation of Nyanza Regional Sports tournament. The committee after deliberation agreed to split the allocation of sports vote to cater for the regional activities.

d. Constituency Oversight Committee budget

The Committee was informed of the new development on a provision of not more than 1% of the constituency allocation towards facilitation of the Constituency Oversight Committee activities in a financial year. The committee upon deliberating on this matter approved Kshs.320,000 as per the breakdown in the budget.

e. Funding of Strategic Plan



The Fund Account manager informed members that the previous strategic plan elapsed and the Board has advised constituency to develop a new strategic plan and the committee resolved to allocate Kshs.2,000,000 towards the project

f. Prioritization of other projects for 2022/2023

The Fund Manager gave an elaborate concern on the project activities that is required by the Board. Key items is to ensure that;

1. Projects are funded to completion
2. Projects of high magnitude are allocated adequate funds that will enable them to be funded within 3 financial years
3. Projects activities must be clear and SMART
4. In allocating funds to projects, adequate consultation with the public works is done to a certain realistic project costing

After lengthy deliberations as summarized above and based on priorities forwarded from the ward meetings, the members approved the projects to factored in the financial year 2022/2023 project in all the four wards in the Constituency as tabulated below: -
