#### KSMEAST/NGCDF/11/11/01/2018: ENGAGEMENT OF INTERNS

Members approved the engagement of interns of 4 interns (for a period of 3 months) to support the activities of NGCDF. The Fund Account Manager will determine the need and engage them accordingly. The interns will be paid a monthly stipend of Ksh 8,000 (Eight Thousand only)

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The Fund Account Manager informed the constituency had been earlier allocated a total of Ksh 101,416,090.34. This was however reviewed downwards to Ksh 86,810,344.82 for the 2017/2018 financial year. He took members through the circular (Ref NG-CDFB/CIRCULAR Vol 1(121) dated July 25, 2017) on the guidelines for submission of 2017/18 project proposal. Members were reminded that the projects to be funded under the NGCDF Act 2015 were those falling under the National Government functions.

In the deliberations, emphasize was placed on the need to give priority to ongoing projects to ensure they are completed within reasonable time. The Fund Account Manager reiterated on the need to have a strategic plan in place to guide future developments.
