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The Chairperson welcomed members to the meeting and briefed them on the day's agenda.

The secretary took members through the minutes of the previous meeting. The minutes of the meeting was proposed by Caroline Opodi as true records of proceedings and seconded by George Ondere.

**KSMEAST/NGCDF/82/16/09/2021: MATTERS ARISING**

The Chairman informed members that a letter to Charles Okello summoning him to come and face the board had not yet been sent to him but will be sent soon.

The Fund Account Manager informed members that the tender notice for various projects were advertised on the Daily Nation Newspaper dated 14<sup>th</sup> September 2021 and sale of tender documents is currently on.

**KSMEAST/NGCDF/83/16/09/2021 REPORTS FROM SUB-COMMITTEES**

**Bursary**

**Social Security Fund (NHIF)**

The Chairperson Bursary Sub-Committee informed members that a final list for subsequent NHIF beneficiaries would be tabled to the committee after replacement of the beneficiaries who are deceased. The payment will be made thereafter.

**Artisan Beneficiaries**

The Chairperson Bursary Sub-Committee informed members that majority of artisan students had reported to Lutheran (TICH) and Chiga Training Institute respectively. He was to make a follow up with the students who had not reported and find out why or otherwise replace them with pending applicants.

**Plant Operators**

The Chairperson Bursary Sub-Committee also informed members that after various consultations with the bursary sub-committee members, the beneficiaries were to join the KHIBIT-Kisii on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Members discussed and agreed that NCCDFC members will accompany the students to Kisii.

Members discussed and agreed unanimously that Ksh. 65,000 (as per the fee structure) will be paid for each student totaling to Ksh. 1,950,000 for the benefit of 30 students as per the attached list.

Members discussed and agreed to pay accommodation for 30 students amounting to Ksh. 240,000 for two months being the period for the entire course.

Members discussed and approved the following budget to support the exercise.

#### Form One Applicants

The Chairperson Bursary Sub-Committee informed member that vetting is over and the Fund Account Manager was mandated to ensure that fund is availed for disbursement as soon as possible to the beneficiaries to enable them continue learning with no interruptions.

#### Monitoring and Evaluation

The Chairperson Monitoring and Evaluation Sub-Committee informed members as follows.

That the construction of 2 classrooms at St. Aloys Mayenya Secondary School was complete and the same was handed over to the school on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

That renovation of 4 classrooms at Obito Primary School was complete and the same was handed over to the school on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2021.

That the proposed construction of 10 door toilets at Okok Primary School was complete and is yet to be handed over.

That proposed renovation of 4 classrooms at Ogango Primary School was still ongoing and the remaining works was fittings and internal plastering.

The Chairperson Monitoring and Evaluation Sub-Committee tabled before the members the benchmarking report held in Mombasa County. Members went through the report and noted that most challenges faced in Mombasa County were almost similar with Kisumu East. This included lack of adequate land, water problems, high number of students due to the Government directive of 100% transition has also led to inadequate classrooms which can accommodate the large number of students.

REVIEW OF PROJECT PROPOSALS FY 2021/2022

Members discussed and agreed that the criteria to be used in identifying the projects that will be funded is to give priority to the projects that did not benefit from the CDF funding in the last financial year 2020/2021. Interest will be in schools that serve as polling stations and those that have most needs.

However the fund Account manager informed members that due to recent price increase of steel materials and the same steel materials are key in roofing of classrooms and other facilities in the constituency, it was therefore prudent for the committee to increase the cost of constructing one classroom. The matter was deliberated deeply by members and finally agreed



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to increase the cost of constructing one classroom by Ksh.50,000 (fifty Thousand) to make it Kshs.1,400,000 up from Kshs.1,350,000 allocated in the last financial Year 2020/2021 Budget allocation.

Members discussed at length and approved the following projects for the financial year 2021/2022 in order of priority.


